





Classroom AI Expectations


Unless otherwise stated, students are permitted to use AI in the methods indicated by a checkmark (✓) to complete assignments for this course.


6  Student copies assignment directions and pastes them into the AI tool as a prompt. Student copies and pastes AI output and submits it to the teacher.

5  Student copies assignment directions and pastes them into the AI tool as a prompt. Student reads, edits, adjusts the output, and then submits to the teacher.

4  Student uses AI to generate multiple responses using a variety of prompts. Student uses best parts of multiple responses, combining them into one response, editing, adding additional information, and then submits to teacher.

3  Student independently writes a thesis statement or claim and then uses AI to generate an outline or brainstorm examples based on the provided thesis. All text in the assignment is written by the student.

2  Student writes a draft independently without the use of AI. Student submits the draft to AI, asking for feedback to improve the assignment. Student uses AI suggestions to edit the assignment.

1  Student completes assignment without consulting AI at any point in the process.

Classroom AI Expectations

Acknowledgment & Attribution

If you use AI in ANY way for an assignment, you must include a statement at the end of the assignment. The statement should:

- 1. Identify the AI tool**
- 2. Explain HOW you used AI. Include your prompts when appropriate.**

Sample Statement

I used Chat GPT 3.5 to complete this assignment. I independently wrote a claim statement, then I engineered this prompt -- *Generate an outline for a 5-paragraph essay based on this claim: WWII led to technological innovations with a lasting impact.* Finally, I referenced the outline created by Chat GPT to then write the essay.

MLA FOR GENERATIVE AI

Acknowledgment & Citation

Writers will:

1. **Create a formal MLA citation** when they paraphrase, quote or incorporate AI-generated content into their work
2. **Use quotation marks** around text incorporated directly from an AI-generated work.
3. **Explain how AI was used** to produce the writing, either in a note at the end or in-text.
