





Setting up your Parent Schoology Access



Step 1: Get the course access codes

In Schooltool, locate your student's access code at the "User Defined" tab. Each student has a unique code (see image on right). In the dropdown menu, select LMS Parent Access Codes.


Use this code when setting up your access at the Schoology website in Step 2 below.


Step 2: Register at Schoology

is: JFTX-PS6T-JWF3R






Step 3: View your student's activity


Click on your student's name to see Schoology from your student's perspective.

Add additional students by clicking the "+ Add Child" button.




