This notice has been prepared and issued in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York State Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617 et seq., the "SEQRA Regulations") (collectively, "SEQRA").

In accordance with applicable law the Brighton Central School District (the "District"), Monroe County, New York proposes to become the lead agency for the coordinated environmental review of the action described below. According to §617.4(b)(6)(i), of the SEQRA Regulations, the proposal is classified as a Type I action.

Enclosed with this notice is the following information: SEQRA Lead Agency Consent Form; completed Part 1 of the Full Environmental Assessment Form (EAF); and a Conceptual Site Plan of the proposed 2017 Capital Improvement Project.

If you consent to the District acting as lead agency, please complete the enclosed form and return it to the address listed. Please note that if you are responding on behalf of an involved agency, if no response to this notice is received within 30 days, the District will be installed as lead agency in accordance with applicable law.

Description of Action:

- Construct 78,583 square feet of 1 & 2 story building addition totaling 134,483 square feet of school building; some of this building addition being 2 stories to limit the building footprint.
- Update the existing access onto Winton Road (Columbus Drive) to allow for one (1) entry lane, two (2) exit lanes (left and right) and add a sidewalk connection to Winton Road. The existing bridge will be replaced (or rehabilitated if appropriate). A new signal light is proposed on Winton Road at the main access to the site (contingent upon approval by the Monroe County Department of Transportation). This driveway will provide access for all vehicles except for neighbors in the Idlewood Drive area as noted below.
- Update the existing driveway off Idlewood Drive to allow parent drop-off for those students where it is more convenient than accessing from Winton Road.
- Construct a school bus drop-off area for 22 full-sized buses accessed from Winton Road. This
 area will also allow parking for 96 vehicles for special events when buses are not present.
- Construction of a 154 car parking lot (staff and visitors) on the west side of the building along with a parent drop-off loop; all accessed from Winton Road.
- Construction of a parent drop-off loop and a hard surface play area on the east side of the building, all accessed from Idlewood Drive. The hard surface play area will also allow parking for 78 vehicles for special events.
- Construction of three (3) playgrounds tailored for kindergarten and elementary aged children.
- Construction of a full-sized multi-purpose playfield.
- Construction of a recreation field.
- Construction of a stormwater management facility to address stormwater quality and quantity in accordance with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Permit No. GP-0-15-002.
- Installation of sidewalks, lighting, drainage, and new utility laterals to service the building.
- Permits for wetland (Federal) disturbance as well as modification to the flood plain associated with Allens Creek.
