Timmy- main character, a perky Boy Scout
Father- Tim's dad, thinks he is a Nazi
Tony- Camp Director
John- Tim's "mentor", another camp staffer
Deon- staff member, a "gangsta" Boy Scout
Adam- staff member, a gay Boy Scout
Ron- staff member, a blind Boy Scout
Alex- staff member, a four armed freak Boy Scout
Mom- Tim's mom
Kid 1- a camper
Kid 2- a camper
Scoutmaster- a troop scoutmaster
Robert- new staffer the next year

Scene: Timmy is in his Dad's car, on the way to Boy Scout camp

Father

So, you're gonna be workin' up at Boy Scout Camp for the

Next 6 weeks?

Timmy

Sure am!

Father

Boy Scout Camp...back in my day, we worked at

Concentration Camps!

Timmy

DAD!!

Father

Remember Timmy, from 1939 to 1945, Germany was on

vacation. Oh and... we didn't invade Poland... they

invited us.

Timmy (to audience)

This, is my dad. For some reason he thinks he's a Nazi. He wanted to make me a Nazi too, but Mom wasn't really up for it. I mean, you're looking at Timmy Adolf Johnson. So, instead of me hanging around my house in the summer, and listening to my dad's crazy Nazi rants, I work at Boy

Scout camp.

Father Alright, we're here. Remember, brush your teeth...

Timmy Alright Dad

Father Change your underwear...

Timmy O.K. Dad

Father AND SHOW NO MERCY!

Timmy DAD! Alright!

(Timmy gets out of the car, grabs his bag and walks up to a door)

Timmy

reading sign on door Camp Director's office...Sign in here! Oh boy!

Tony Hey! Are you from KFC?

Timmy uhh...no, I'm here to sign in. I'll be working for you this

summer. I'm your new employee, or as I like to say,

employWEE! (laughs)

Tony Oh...wow...sooo... you didn't bring any chicken?

Timmy No, was I supposed to?

Tony um, what? Oh, no... umm... here's your uniform, nametag,

and any other materials you're gonna need. You can go

ahead up to the campsite so you can find your tent.

Timmy Thanks... um, wait. You got my nametag wrong.

(To audience)

sharin' a tent 'aight?

Timmy What tent fee?

Deon Say What?? You didn't know about the tent fee? Well,

Nathan

Timmy (To Audience)

But, I did finally get to sleep, and the next day I was sooo excited to see all the troops arrive. But before they had a chance to arrive, I actually got a letter in the mail from my mom! I was so excited to read it!!

Mom

Hello, Son. I was going to wait and tell you when you got back, but I just can't hold it in. Your Grandma died. It was a stroke. And your little sister, Susie, stepped in front of a bus. She's dead too. Oh, and your father and I are getting a divorce... that crazy Nazi bastard. Well, see you in a few weeks! Love, Mom

Timmy (to audience)

Well, actually, I guess that was bad news, it actually kind of lowered my scout spirit levels. I decided that I should probably take out my ring.... (takes out ring) With this ring, I, Timmy Adolf Johnson, hereby up my Scout Spirit! (thrusts ring in air)... Also, I knew that the arrival of the troops would put me in a better mood. After waiting for just a while longer, I saw the troop I was assigned to help for the week pull up, and I went over to greet them.

Scoutmaster Alright, Men, line up. No slackers this week, you call

everyone over the age of 18 Sir, do I make myself clear?

Kid 1,2 Yes, Sir!

Deon (looks around) | L..L..don't know...

Scoutmaster

Would you take us on the tour now?

Timmy (to audience)

Well, the weeks passed and learned a lot of cool stuff, like

public showers with Adam...

Adam

How YOU doin'?

Timmy (to audience)

How to sing campfire songs...

John

Let's sing a campfire song!

Timmy

Okay, I know Home on the Range

John

No... we sing... different campfire songs

John (rapping)

Hump...de Dump... Hump Hump... de Dumpty Dumpty... Hump... de Dump... Hump Hump... de Dumpty Dumpty... Humpty Dumpty Sat on a wall, Humpty Dumpty had a great fall.
