PERSONAL STATEMENT

This introductory video project serves a variety of needs;

- Introduces you to the computer lab and video studio
- Checks your personal log-on and student account
- Allows me to get acquainted with you
- Introduces you to non-linear video editing
- · Learn to write for camera and consider word count

The sequence of this project should be as follows;

- Log-on to your computer and open a new word document
- Type your name and Video Communications
- Do a file save-as "Personal Statement"
- Save it into your personal network account
- Write a one to two minute factual statement about yourself
- Test the length by reading it quietly and timing it (must be 1-2min)
- Do a word count and key it in somewhere on the bottom. You will most likely need to be around 250 or 300 words.
- Save your work
- Print one copy on the 2200DN printer (default printer) and turn in.
- Make up note cards, an enlarged copy or an outline sheet if you wish. You
 will not read this "word for word" when we shoot your Personal Statement
- Work with classmates in the studio to tape your statement (more on this latter)
