WHY JOIN A SNOWSPORTS CLUB?

Bristol Mountain Snowsports Clubs are the best way for students to get outside, be active, hang out with their friends (or make new ones!), and have fun during the winter months.

WHAT IS A SNOWSPORTS CLUB MEMBERSHIP?

A Student Snowsports Club Pass is valid every week on the night/day and time chosen from the start of our Twilight Season (tentatively scheduled on December 15th) through March 9th. The Snowsports Club Season Pass is valid even on weeks when your Snowsports Club isn't scheduled to visit!

IS THERE RENTAL EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE?

Yes! Bristol Mountain offers a variety of different equipment rental options to best suit your child's needs when they visit. The Season Equipment Rental allows your student 1 rental per day for the entire 2023-24 season. We also offer 4 visit or 6 visit rental options if you only plan to come a limited number of times.

Ski rentals include skis, boots, and poles. Snowboard rentals include snowboard and boots. Helmets are not included and can be rented individually. Students will also have access to purchase steeply discounted helmets through the ecommerce store.

Please remind your child to return rental equipment to the Experience Center at the end of the evening. There is a \$10 fee that is charged for equipment that is not returned to the Rental Shop at the end of every evening.

DO YOU OFFER LESSONS?

Lessons are sold as an add-on to the Snowsports Club experience. Lesson packages include four 1-hour class lesson. Each student can purchase one package of lessons per season. Lessons are offered between January 2nd and January 29th with a make-up week of January 30th – February 5th. There will be no lessons after February 6th. Lessons are available for both students and parents. The 1-hour parent lessons are held at the same times and with the same groups as the student lessons. Students will meet for lessons at the Snowsports School Meeting Place.

WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING TO SNOWSPORTS CLUB?

- Snowsports Equipment
Unless you are picking up rental equipment from the Experience Center.
- Winter Clothes
Layer up starting with a base layer top and bottom, ski/snow pants, ski/snow jacket, face mask/buff/neck gaiter, ski/snow socks, warm/waterproof gloves, snow goggles.

- ❑ Money for Extra Purchases

If your student is purchasing food, money can be loaded onto their gateway card (ski pass), a fingerprint can be uploaded and attached to their account for purchases, gift cards can be purchased or make sure they have cash or a card.

- ❑ Gateway Card

Snowsports Club Advisors will distribute these before the start of the season. If your child forgets' s their Gateway Card a replacement can be purchased for \$5.

IS THERE A SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE?

The Scott Delforte Foundation will be offering scholarships to eligible students this year. The program will be awarded to individuals wishing to participate in their school's snowsports program with special considerations and weight given to a needs basis. Other criteria include; those who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and exemplary school conduct, and based on the content of the applicants' essay.

The program will provide the recipient with all of the registration fees required in recipient's snowsports club program.
