



### 2020 - 2021 TEACHING & LEARNING FAMILY OPTIONS

- Comprehensive Distance Learning All classes are taught virtually. <u>Classes start Sept 14th.</u>
- Hybrid Learning Option for students to receive in-person learning two days per week while also receiving virtual instruction three days per week.
- Bethel Online Academy yearlong option to learn virtually. Bethel curriculum taught by WHS teachers.



## WILLAMETTE YEAR LONG SCHEDULE

### These features are consistent in CDL, Hybrid and BOA:

- > Six terms over the course of the year.
- > Each term is six weeks long.
- > Students will take three classes per term. (.5 credit per class)
- > Classes will be offered virtually and/or in-person.
- > Daily classes & attendance.
- > Daily office hours for students to work with teachers beyond class time.



### COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING & HYBRID MODELS

Student Engagement - Friends, Fun and School!

Models are Parallel - Student/Family/Staff-Friendly

### **Critical Components:**

- > Regular access to WHS teachers
- > Bethel curriculum
- > Student and family supports
- > Tests, assignments & letter grades

### TEACHER-PLANNED & APPLIED LEARNING DEFINED

### Teacher-Planned & Facilitated Learning:

- > Synchronous ("live") or asynchronous ("flexible/recorded")
- > Learning designed to develop, deepen, assess new knowledge and understanding related to state content standards.

### Applied Learning:

- > Allows for students to practice knowledge and skills that extend from the teacher-facilitated learning.
- > Conducted asynchronously.
- > E.g. practice, homework, independent work

# Comprehensive Distance Learning Schedule:

- Three classes per student
- Daily lessons and attendance
- Teacher support offered daily



# Example Classroom Based Schedule

- Families may opt into the Bethel Online Academy

Hybrid learning will be an option when state & county health metrics allow.
