1. The majority of courses taught will be taught at the honors level. Our instructional program involves hands-on learning. You cannot sit and be a spectator in your education. This means you will have to participate in your own learning. No longer will the teacher be doing all the work, while the students sit passively and absorb.		
2. ECHS will operate on a different calendar than Cabarrus County Schools.		
3. All students must start with taking Math I even if they took Math I in 8 th grade.		
4. Students must be willing to devote a minimum of (2) hours each evening to homework and studying and that those hours may increase as college coursework increases. Our expectation is that you will do all the work that is assigned in a timely manner.		
5. Students must make academic progress each semester to remain at ECHS.		
6. Students must maintain good behavior to remain at ECHS. Serious or frequent behavior violations can result in removal from ECHS.		
7. College courses are taught by college instructors on a college level. They will not change anything that they do for Early College students. You will be expected to do all the same work as the adults in the class.		
8. Grades earned in college courses must be a "C" or higher to transfer.		
9. Students will be responsible for fees and books for any college course that must be retaken because of a failing grade.		
10. Because our field trips are considered an extension of our classrooms, it is the expectation that every student participate unless there are academic/behavioral reasons or extenuating circumstances.		
11. Requests for a transfer to another high school within Cabarrus County will only be accepted at the end of each school year.		
12. Students will not be allowed to graduate early unless they can earn both the high school diploma and associate degree.		
13. Early College students that transfer to their traditional school will not be allowed to graduate early until they finish their 1 st semester of their senior year.
