#### READING:

Students worked incredibly hard this week on their iReady Reading diagnostics. We will wrap those up this week! Once all students finish, you can expect students to pass 2 lessons per week- these can be completed for homework or during early finisher class time. This week readers will learn the 5 types of context clues and how to determine the meaning of unknown words. We will also begin an important reading strategy called signposts!

#### **SOCIAL STUDIES:**

We are continuing our focus on North Carolina! We will wrap up our study on the geographical regions of NC and begin our study of Colonial NC. We will study the colonization and effect Europeans had on indigenous groups already living in the different regions.

### MATH:

This week we will be reviewing data! Students will be collecting data, making a representation of data and interpreting data in frequency tables, scaling bar graphs, and/or line plots. Students will also be determining whether a survey question will yield categorical or numerical data. Students have finished their iReady Math diagnostics and will be starting their iReady lessons for homework next week. They are required to pass two lessons each.

### **SCIENCE:**

Our science unit is all about the Earth! Students will be able to explain the cause of day and night based on the rotation of Earth on its axis.


