Clever Login Directions

- Direct your child to web browser of choice (Chrome, Safari, Firefox)
- Have your child access school Webpage: (Patriots: cabarrus.k12.nc.us/Domain/17)
- Clever
- Direct your child to click on the blue clever badge
- Once they click on clever icon, click "Log in with Active Directory"



- Type in Student username and password they use to login to computers and accounts at school [usually FirstinitialLastname####] (first initial, last name, last 4 of student id #, and password: full student id #)
- Then, your child may click on the icon of the application/program you would like them to work in. Their login should be automatic to iReady.

Login Instructions

Step 1: Go to www.kidsa-z.com

Step 2: Enter or choose the teacher's username. (Contact your child's teacher for this information)

Step 3: Your child finds his or her username on the class chart.

Step 4: Your child enters his or her password.







Google Classroom

Google Classroom is an online platform for teachers to create assignments that students will complete. These assignments are then saved to the students google drive where you can review them at home.

Step 1: Go to www.classroom.google.com

Step 2: Type in student school email and password [usually FirstinitialLastname### @st.cabarrus.k12.nc.us] (first initial, last name, last 4 of student id #@st.cabarrus.k12.c.us, and password: full student id #)

Step 3: Your child should click on the class that houses the assignment they are needing.





Mastery Connect

Mastery Connect is an online assessment platform that allows students to efficiently demonstrate their knowledge of the standards covered within the classroom. Parents can view student's scores and assignments.

Step 1: Go to the Patriots homepage

Step 2: Click on Clever



Step 3: Have your student sign-in with their normal username and password

Step 4: Click on Mastery Connect

Step 5: Have the student click on any assignment you wish to review with them.

Seesaw

Seesaw is a digital portfolio that gives you real-time glimpses into your child's school day. **Seesaw** helps you stay in the loop and gives you an opportunity to support your child's learning at home.



Login Instructions

Step 1: Download the Seesaw Family app from your app store

Step 2: Sign up as a parent

Step 3: Connect to your student's journal using the QR code or link your child's teacher provided

Step 4: Enjoy keeping up with your student's day
