

# Applying for a Library Card

A library card allows you to use all the resources of the library. In order to obtain a library card, fill out a registration form. If you are 14 years of age or under, you must obtain the signature of your parent or legal guardian.

In addition to the completed form, you must provide one form of acceptable proof of identification and/or current residency, such as a driver's license, state identification card, utility bill, bank statement, or tax bill.

Submit your completed form and proof of identification to one of the librarians at the main desk.
