

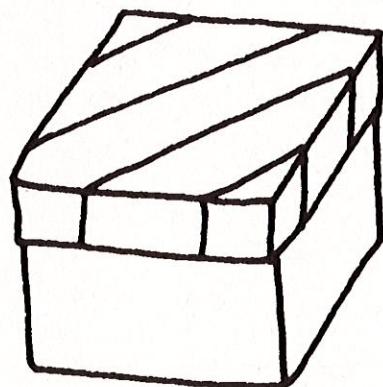
This selection describes how to decorate a box. Read the selection. Then, answer the questions. On your answer sheet, darken the circle for each correct answer for multiple-choice items. For the short-answer item, write your answer on a separate sheet of paper.

Decorate a Treasure Box

Materials

- thick drawing paper
- crayons or markers
- small box with lid
- decoupage glue (*available at craft stores*)
- brush
- scissors

1. Cut a piece of paper the same size as the lid of the box.
2. On the paper, draw a picture with crayons or markers.
3. Use a brush to cover the back of the picture with decoupage glue. Place the picture on the lid of your box.
4. Let the picture dry for two hours.
5. Coat the picture with another layer of glue, and let it dry overnight.
