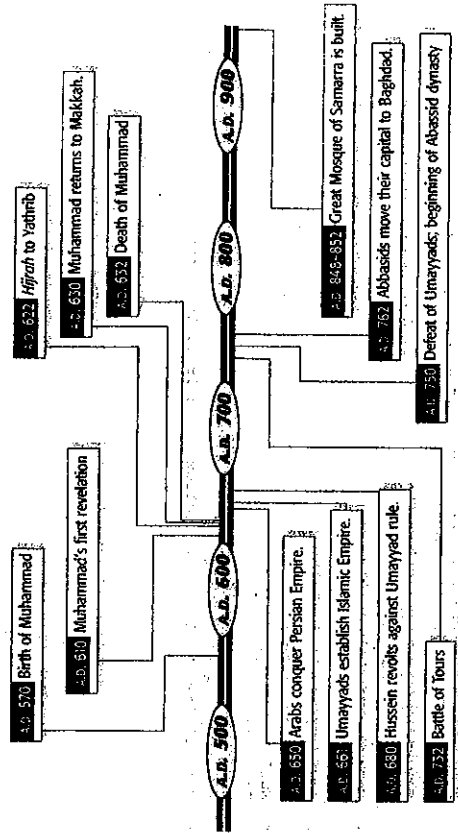

The World of Islam

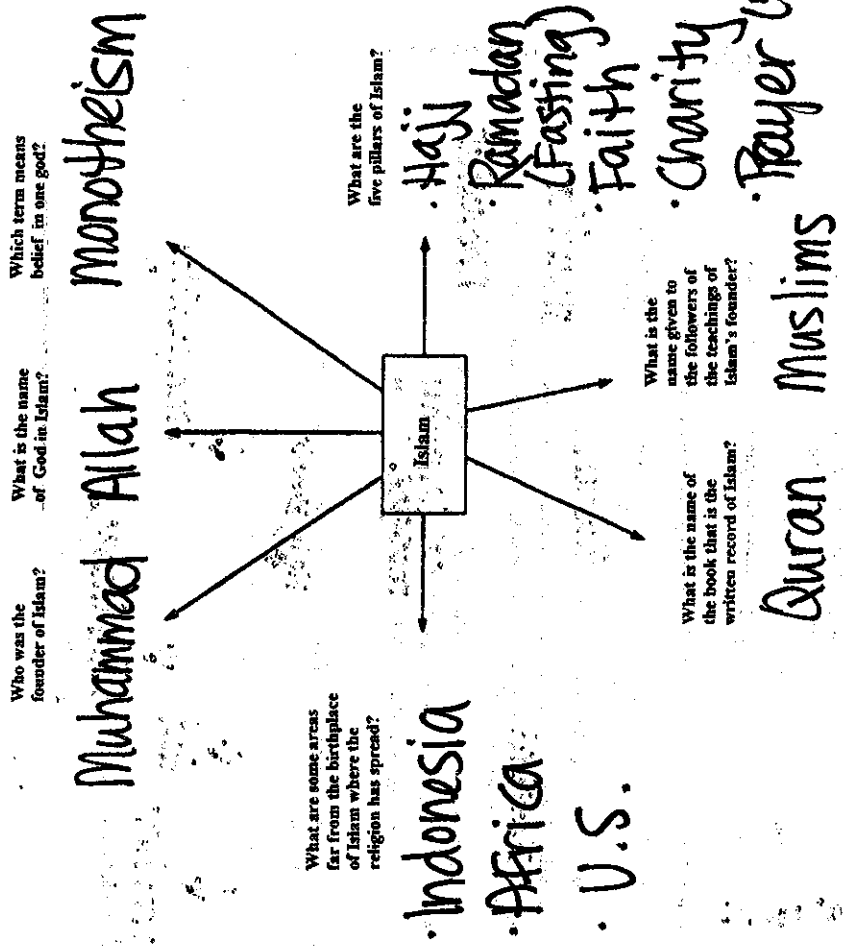
DIRECTIONS: The first centuries of Islamic civilization were a time of expansion and accomplishment. Read the time line below, then answer the questions that follow.

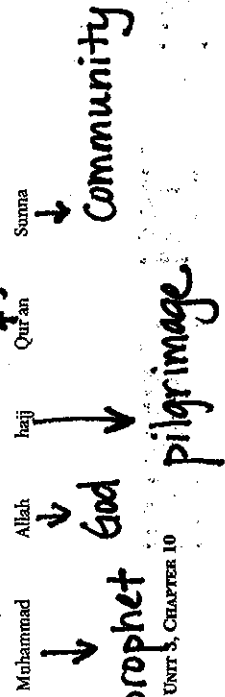
