Legal Aid of NC provides free legal help to low-income North Carolinians in civil cases involving basic human needs like safety, shelter, income and more.

TYPES OF CASES WE HANDLE:

HOUSING

- Evictions
- Habitability (safety and maintenance)
- Admissions to public housing
- Terminations of housing subsidies (ex. Section 8 vouchers)
- Housing discrimination

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & SEXUAL ASSAULT

- Protective orders (50B)
- Child custody for victims and children exposed to violence or sexual abuse
- Other services – housing, finances, etc. – that will help stop the violence

CONSUMER

- Bankruptcy
- Debt collection
- Illegal trade practices
- Foreclosure
- Repossession

EMPLOYMENT

- Unemployment insurance
- Wage theft
- Denial/loss of occupational licenses

PUBLIC BENEFITS

- Denials, terminations, reductions and overpayments
- Food stamps
- Medicaid and Medicare
- Social Security
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Supplemental Security Disability Income (SSDI)

AND MORE

- **Human Trafficking:** Immigration status, permission to work, refugee certification
- **Veterans:** Disability compensation, discharge upgrades, overpayments, pension benefits
- **Community Economic Development:** Job readiness, small business development, affordable housing
- **Natural Disasters:** Housing, benefits, consumer issues, insurance and more
- **Education:** School enrollment, discipline, special education and more
- **Advance Directives:** Wills, living wills, powers of attorney, health care powers of attorney
- **Immigration:** Immigration relief for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking and other violence
- **Expunction:** Expunctions, certificates of relief
- **Native Americans:** Federal recognition, domestic violence, adoption, housing, Tribal Court

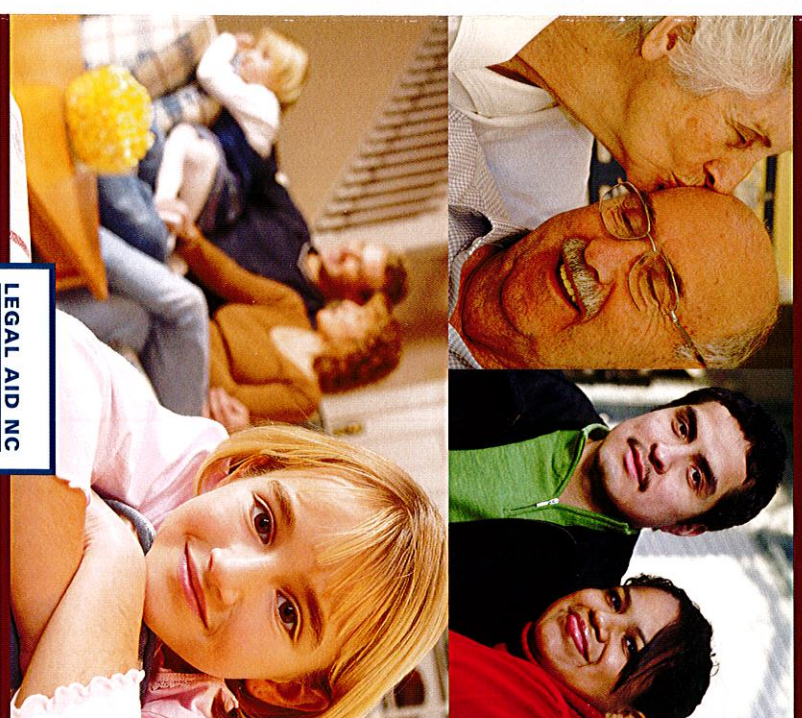

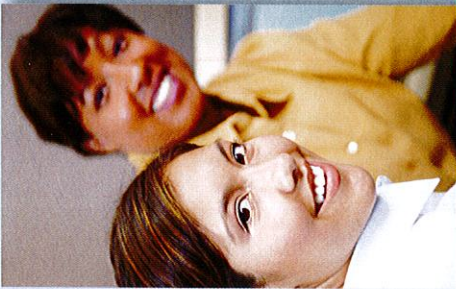

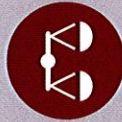
