preparation

responsibility

All work will be updated weekly via POWERSCHOOL. The PowerSchool Grade is your Class Grade. Canvas and other online platforms only provide feedback for those individual assignments. Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a grade. This can be done via e-mail or in person.

All students are expected to be familiar with and PowerSchool understand the academic honesty policy in the NCHS code of conduct as it applies to acts of plagiary and cheating. All submitted work must reflect your own thoughts and writing style. Violations will automatically result in the denial of credit for this work and a disciplinary referral.

This semester our department is offering math makeup sessions run by each teacher.
