Carefully read and consider the following commitments. All participating students & their parents/guardians must sign this before participating in NC Virtual Public School (NCVPS) courses.

COURSE REQUEST: I realize I can only select a course that is not available at my high school.

TIME: I will spend at least twelve (12) hours weekly working on the NCVPS web site and/or assigned modules until all course requirements are completed. More time may be required. Summer classes are condensed into 7 weeks and will require a greater time commitment.

ENROLLMENT: I will be dropped from the course if I fail to log on during the first 10 days and/or my name appears on the NCVPS *Inactive Reports*, and this will result in the grade of **WF (Withdraw Failing)** on my high school transcript. Even if NCVPS allows me to drop a course without penalty, a grade of WF will appear on my CCS high school transcript and will negatively impact my GPA.

INSTRUCTOR: I will email or call the assigned NCVPS teacher if I have questions or need help; my high school will not be able to provide assistance or support with course content.

PROGRAM: I have read, understand, and will obey all rules and policies set forth for participation in the NCVPS programs.

TESTING: I will take all required EOC or CTE state mandated exams in person at a location designated by my high school testing coordinator. I understand that EOC and CTE state mandated exams count as 25% of my final grade.

GRADING: I will earn the grade as determined by NCVPS. I understand that all grades in online courses will be recorded on my High School transcript and will be factored in my GPA/Class Rank calculation. **Failing this course will negatively impact my high school GPA.**

INTEGRITY: I will do all work myself. Allowing another student to perform work for courses for which I am registered is cheating and a violation of the Student Code of Conduct. Such actions will result in a grade of "F" for the course as well as disciplinary consequences.

LOCATION: If I take an NCVPS course while remaining on campus, I know that I must report to the room number stated on the schedule. Attendance is taken daily and a teacher is available to help with technology as needed. If I take an NCVPS course from home, I know that I must have daily, reliable transportation. I know that I cannot come and go from school so I can only take a NCVPS class from home if it works in my schedule, at the beginning of my day or the end.

***Failure to make adequate progress will result in losing the privilege to continue to enroll in NCVPS classes and/or the privilege to take the courses off campus.**
