It cools them off.



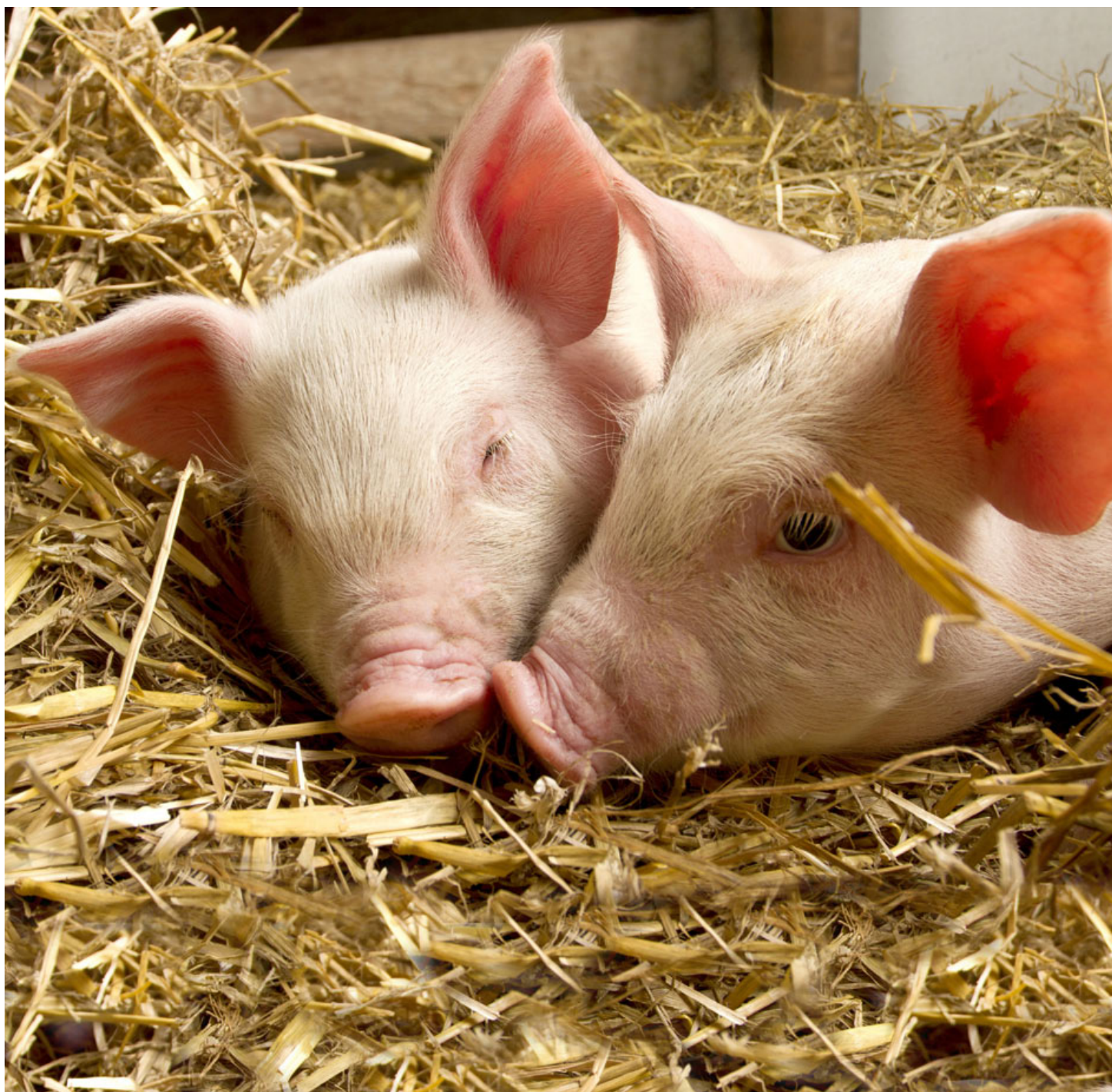
Pigs **cuddle** with their friends.
