School and Community:

Early College high schools are public high schools located on two- and four-year college campuses that blend both the high school and college curriculum. Students graduate high school with a North Carolina high school diploma and Associate's Degree. The Cabarrus-Kannapolis Early College High School serves a diverse population of 240 students. C-KECHS is located on the Rowan Cabarrus Community College south campus in Concord, North Carolina and serves students across Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City.

Students receive numeric grades on a 100-point scale. Grade Point Averages (GPAs) are calculated on a four-point [4.0] scale converted from numeric scores. Each honor and college-level course is weighted and adds additional quality GPA points. Because students take college-level courses each year, ECHS does not offer Advanced Placement courses.

Class Rank:

Students who are in grade 13 are not included with the senior class and are ranked among their previous class. Class rank for students in grades 12 and 13 may not accurately represent their rank among their graduating class. Please direct your attention to the counselor's report form and/or letter of recommendation for students' true rank.

Graduation Requirements:

All students are required to complete a minimum of 27 credits to graduate. All students graduate with a North Carolina Future-Ready Core Diploma.

Extra-curricular Activities:

Students are required to participate in clubs and community service projects as part of their curriculum. C-KECHS offers several clubs and organizations for students to grow in leadership and service, recognize achievements and honors, and allow for exploration of individual interests.
