



**Ancient Greece: Comparing Sparta and Athens**

Social Structure		
Lifestyle/Values	Death for Sparta! Nationalism Power Discipline Militarism	Education, Philosophy Theater/Entertainment Music
How Children were Raised	<u>Boys</u> Go to military school @ age 7 → 30 years  <u>Girls</u> learn hunting, sports, defense, homemaking	<u>Boys</u> Go to school politics, philosophy, rhetoric  <u>Girls</u> No school - learn homemaking from Mom
Roles of Men and Women	<u>MEN</u> - soldiers, political leaders married @ 30  <u>WOMEN</u> married young, ↑ rights, <u>HOMEMAKERS</u>	<u>MEN</u> - Political rights, actors, politicians, philosopher, scholars  <u>WOMEN</u> married young, no political rights, couldn't leave home
Government & Political Organization	<u>OLIGARCHY</u> (few in charge) • 2 Kings • 5 Ephors (judges) • Council of Elders	<u>DEMOCRACY</u> (direct) • all male citizens can / should participate • Assembly
Result of Great Peloponnesian War	WINNER! Rules Athens 27 years	• men & women enslaved
