Rules and expectations

Technology in class

The use of technology for purposes other than educational will not be tolerated in class. This means that there will be no games, YouTube videos, or social media usage during class. I will be monitoring Chromebooks using DyKnow.

Translators

I understand it can be frustrating to learn a new language. However, it is perfectly okay to feel like you are communicating in basic sentences—that's what we're supposed to be doing.

The use of Google Translate to write full sentences and/or paragraphs will not be tolerated and will result in parental contact. Using an online translator to complete assignments is considered **cheating**. Use your class resources and ask for help if you need it!

Extra credit/make ups

There will be opportunities for extra credit throughout the semester. Extra credit cannot be completed if the student has missing work.

All work must be turned in to be eligible for extra credit.

If a student wants to make up a low test grade, they must first attend a tutoring session. Tests must be made up within 10 days of receiving the grade.
