

# Fall Into A Good Book Family Night

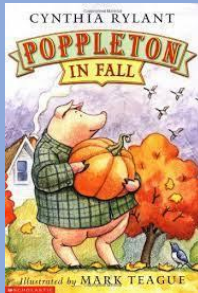
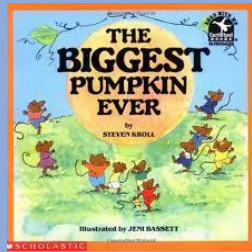
October 28<sup>th</sup> 5:30-6:40
