Directions:

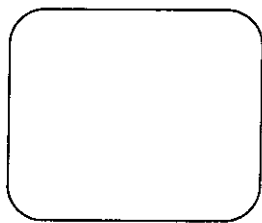
1. Use 4 pictures or drawings of YOU and your family. Use pictures from when you were born to how you look now!
2. Organize your pictures in **sequence order**. (from birth to present)
3. **PHOTO CAPTION-** Label each picture with the **date or your age** and write a **complete sentence** describing each picture.
 - If you do not know the exact date, write how old you were in the picture.
 - Make sure the date and sentence is under the picture you are describing!
4. Decorate your timeline and make it neat!

You can get **FIVE** extra bonus points if you include **2 extra pictures/drawing** on your timeline!

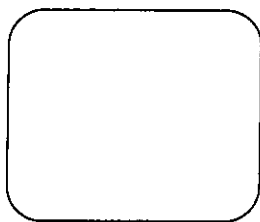

Timeline of your name!



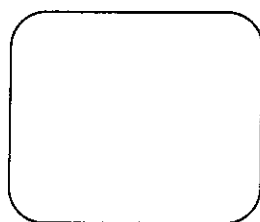
September 25,

me when I was born.



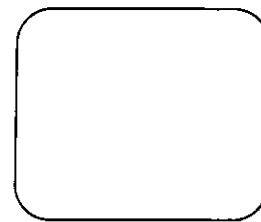
October 2, 2010
