8th Grade Parents,

We are excited to announce the second annual Eighth Grade Trip!! This year we are going to Washington, DC, April 16-19, 2024. We will

leave early on Wednesday morning, April 16 and return late on Friday, April 19. We will travel by charter bus through the touring company Burke Educational Travel. An itinerary is attached to this letter.

COST

The total cost for this trip will be approximately \$650 per student. This will cover bus, driver, accommodations, tickets to historic sites and museums, and seven meals. This amount also includes security at our hotel. **Students will also need money for three (3) meals not included in the trip and souvenirs**. We will pack lunches for the first day and cafeteria lunches will be available. Breakfast and one other meal will be provided each day. \$90-\$100 should cover all additional expenses.

WHO CAN GO?

We are asking that students going should maintain academic and behavioral expectations in order to represent our school and community well on a school trip out of state. Here are our expectations:

Academic Expectations:

Passing all Core Classes for 1st & 2nd Nine Weeks

Behavior Expectations: Students with SIX strikes will not be eligible to attend.

OSS=6 strikes ISS (Whole Day)=2 strikes, 1 strike per partial day Office Referral=1 strike Office Referral with consequences=Strikes per consequence Matrix Marks=2 Matrix Marks = 1 strike

ROOMS AND TOUR GROUPS

Students will sleep four to a room. Parents and students do not room together. A few weeks before the trip, students will request their roommates. Most students will get their requests. Tour Groups will be determined by 8th grade teachers.

CHAPERONES

We would like to have some parent chaperones; however, we will have limited space for parent chaperones. Cost for parents is **\$650** because parents sleep two to a room. Parent chaperones will also be required to pay an **additional fee** for a background check that is required by the

Board of Education and each will be required to follow a school chaperone code of conduct. This is by no means a "restful" vacation. This trip requires us to move at a faster than average pace and involves a great deal of walking. Chaperones will be responsible for helping enforce rules and making the trip run smoothly. Chaperones will be assigned a tour group of students whom they must keep with them at all times. If you are interested in chaperoning, complete the additional form and send in a **\$100** deposit to hold your space. (If you send in a chaperone deposit and are unable to go on the trip, the deposit will be applied to your child's account.) As the trip approaches we will know how many students are going and how much space we have for parents. We will let you know at that time who our chaperones will be and have a meeting for those chaperones before the trip.

PAYMENT PLAN:

If your child is interested in attending, please fill out the attached form with a non-refundable \$100 deposit and return it to your Homeroom teacher at GMS. You are welcome to pay as much as you can at any time, but here is a suggested payment plan:

September 30, 2023 = \$100 non-refundable deposit October 31, 2023 = \$100 November 30, 2023 = \$100 January 10, 2024 = \$100 February 10, 2024 = \$100 March 10, 2024 = \$150 (or remaining balance due)
