According to the US Dept. of Education...

Title I, Part A (Title I) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provides financial assistance to local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards.

Funding

Kings Creek School does receive funding from Title I funds. For the 2023-24

school year, our Title I funding is used in the following ways:

28% - Instructional Supplies, Digital Resources, Library Books, etc.

40% - Personnel (Teacher Coach & Reading Interventionist)

30% - Teacher Training (Reading & Math Intervention & Core Instruction, Subs, etc.)

There is also a small amount (1.5%) set aside for Parent Involvement that includes materials for a reading night in fall and a math night in spring.

Parent Reading & Math Workshop Nights at Kings Creek

Why do we have Reading & Math nights?

- Increase the knowledge level of parents and family members about things they can do at home to help nurture readers and develop a love of math.
- Involve more parents and family members in the education of their children and help them feel welcome as learning partners.
- Provide fun, free, multi-generational activities where families and teaching staff can show students that they value reading, math and all learning.

Often students and parents will receive incentives for attending Reading & Math nights because it is so important for families to support students as they learn to read, read to learn, and learn to love math. These skills will last them a lifetime.

Studies clearly show that children whose parents are involved & attend these kinds of events statistically do better in a their classes so we hope that you will attend.

PAC - Parent Advisory Council (PTO)

- Meets two times annually (fall and spring) as part of the PTO.
- Reviews & revises the Student-Parent-School Compact that governs expectations for all
 of us as we interact at Kings Creek School.
- Reviews & revises the Parent & Family Engagement policy that encourages parental involvement in student education.
- Gives feedback on School Improvement Goals/Plan and other school items the Principal may bring to the group.
- The group serves as advisors to the principal about parent concerns, celebrations, and needs.
