This year NASP (National Archery in the Schools Program) will be offered at Hudson Middle School. The safety classes will be taught at the HUB gym after sign ups. This is basic archery safety and does not include any shooting or handling of a bow or arrows. This class will help all students stay safe at home and at school. The program highlights safety, history, how the program works and the availability for future participation. After this one meeting, each student will have 5 days of practice or tryouts. You must attend on the days assigned. If you can not attend you will have to wait until the end of tryouts for another chance. Due to time and limited space these slots are limited.

The archery program will last from start of school through March 1 for the regular season or until May for anyone who qualifies for the National Championships. Shooting will begin in September after signups until late in October. The Archery Team will be chosen in October after try outs. This team is chosen based on shooting ability, scoring, behavior and attendance at school. This includes tardies and checkouts. Practice will be at least 3 times a week and you must attend. The practices will be at the old Horizons gym/HUB from 5:30 pm til 7:00pm. Your parents will have to pick you up at that time. No walking to practice or back to school will be allowed. If you play sports cheer lead, band, chorus and other personal activities you will have to remember practice is a must in all sports. If you play other sports or do other activities and would like to try archery do not assume you cannot because of other things please see Coach Knight, Coach C. Joplin or Coach Helms to check possible participation. Choose the best choice for you or what you like best. For any sport you will not be allowed to join later or after the season has started. Please see Coach Knight, Coach C. Joplin, or Coach Helms for help. All coaches have been trained by a North Carolina Wildlife officer and attended the correct amount of training to be qualified to teach this great program. All questions please see;
