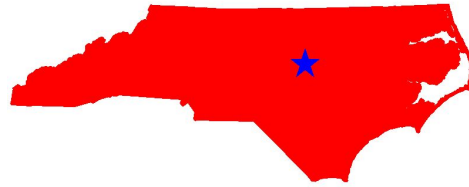
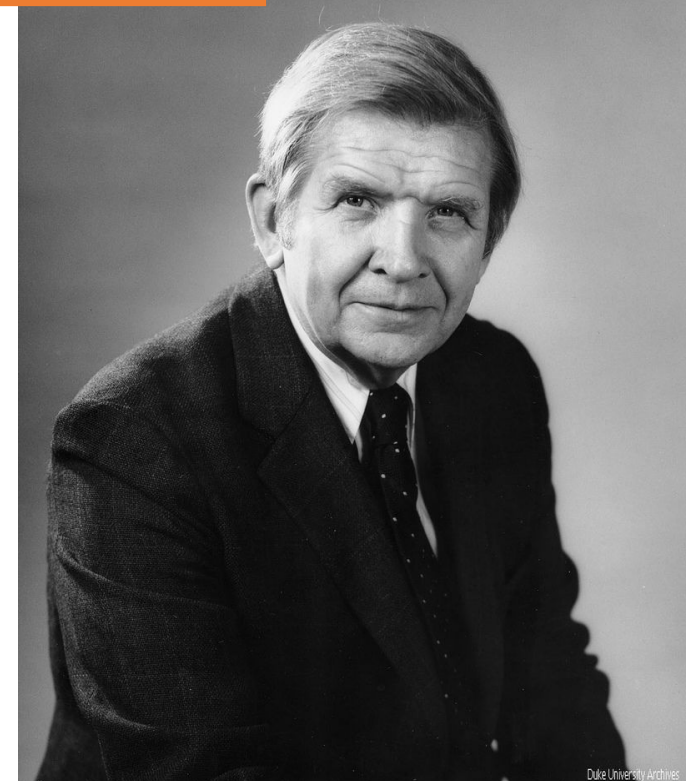
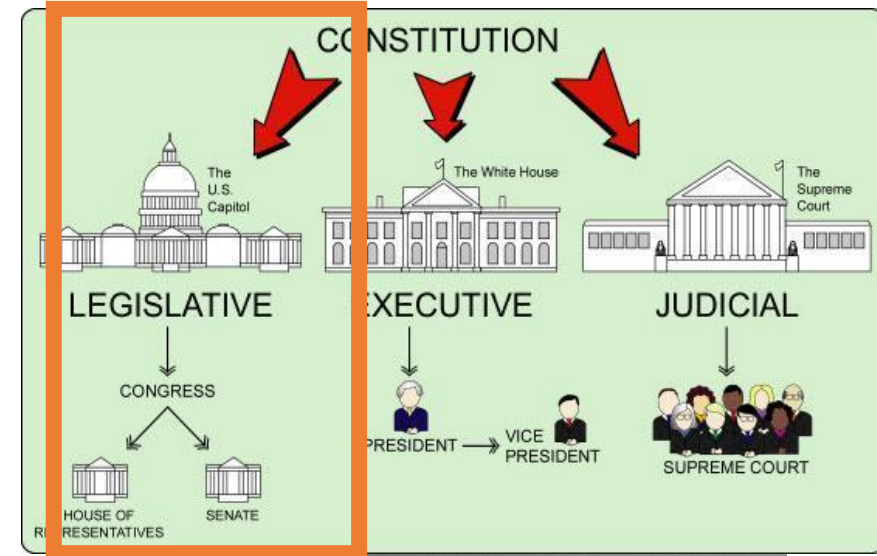


# Terry Sanford



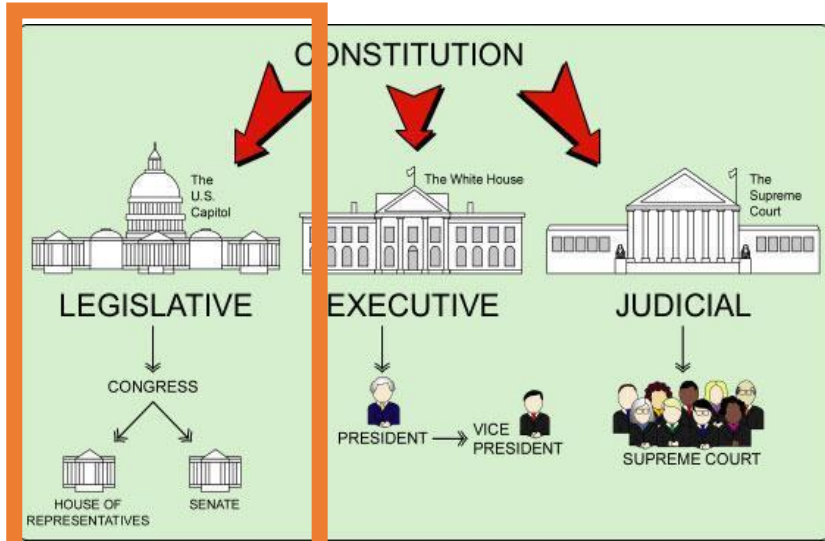
- Governor of NC

# Jim Hunt

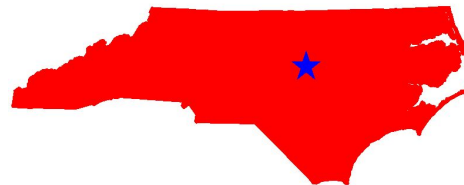
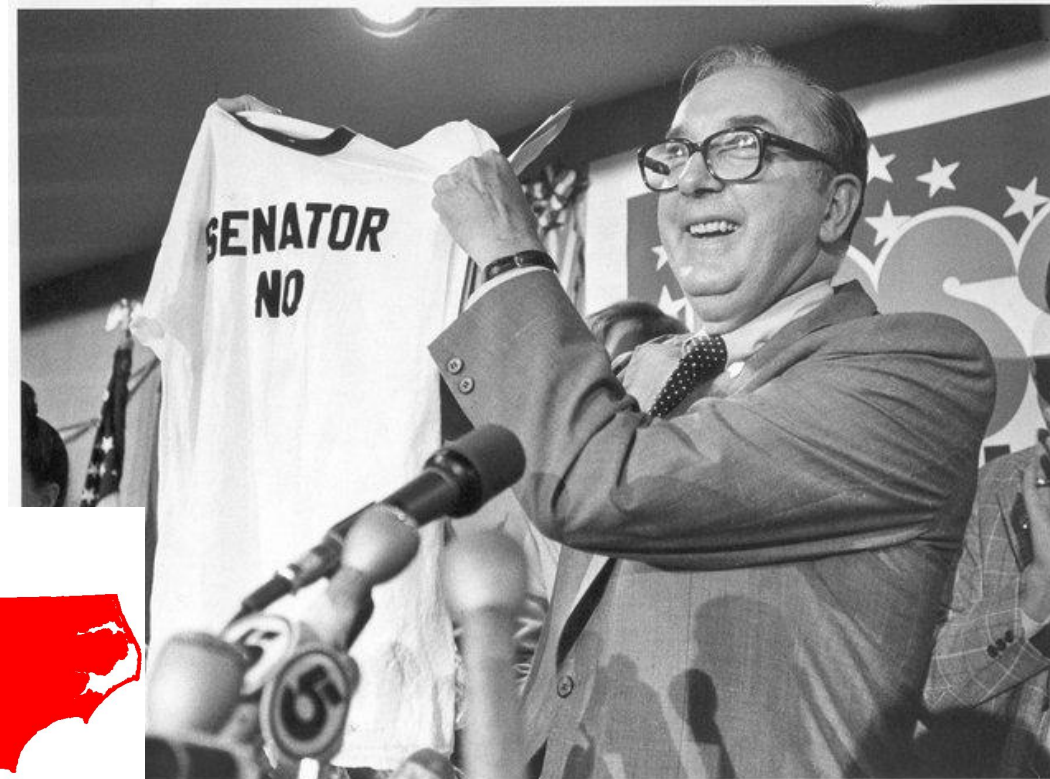
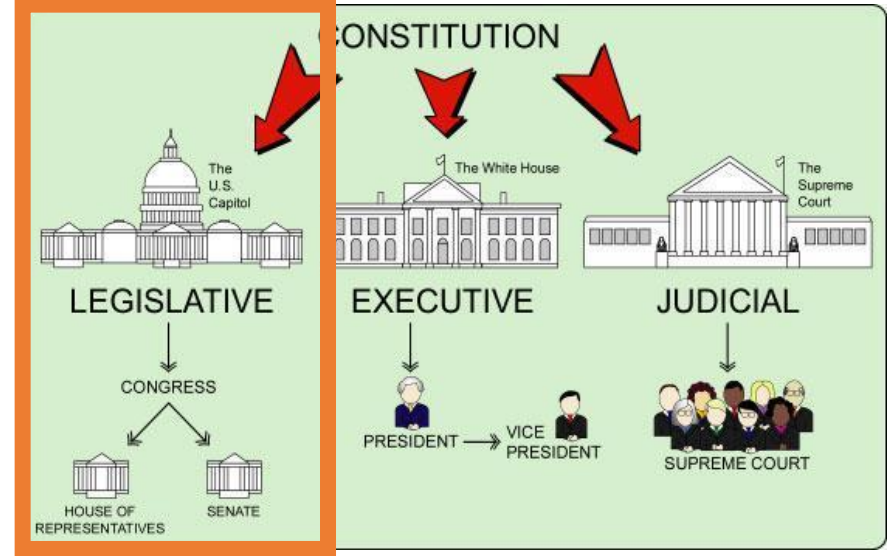


- One of longest serving Governors in US (16 years)

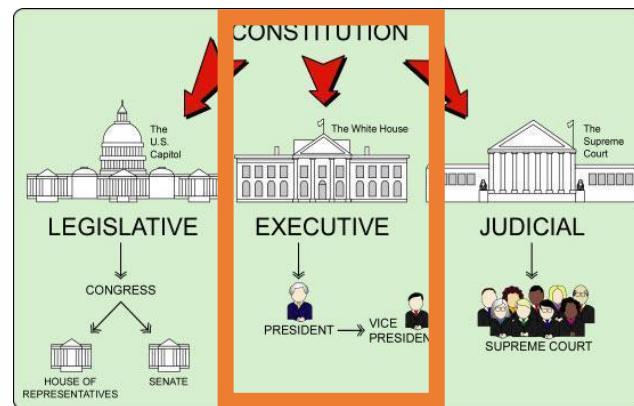
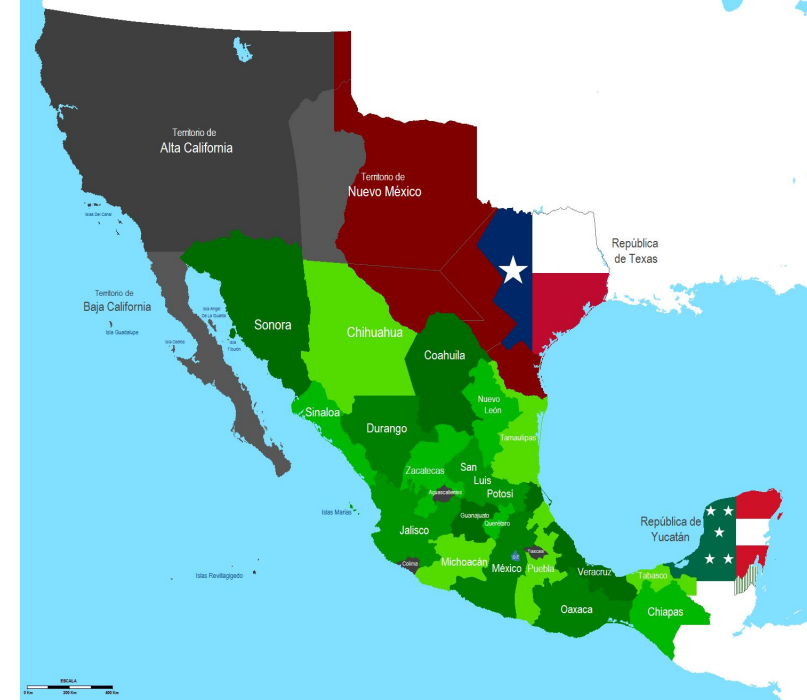
- TV commentator

  - MLK Day





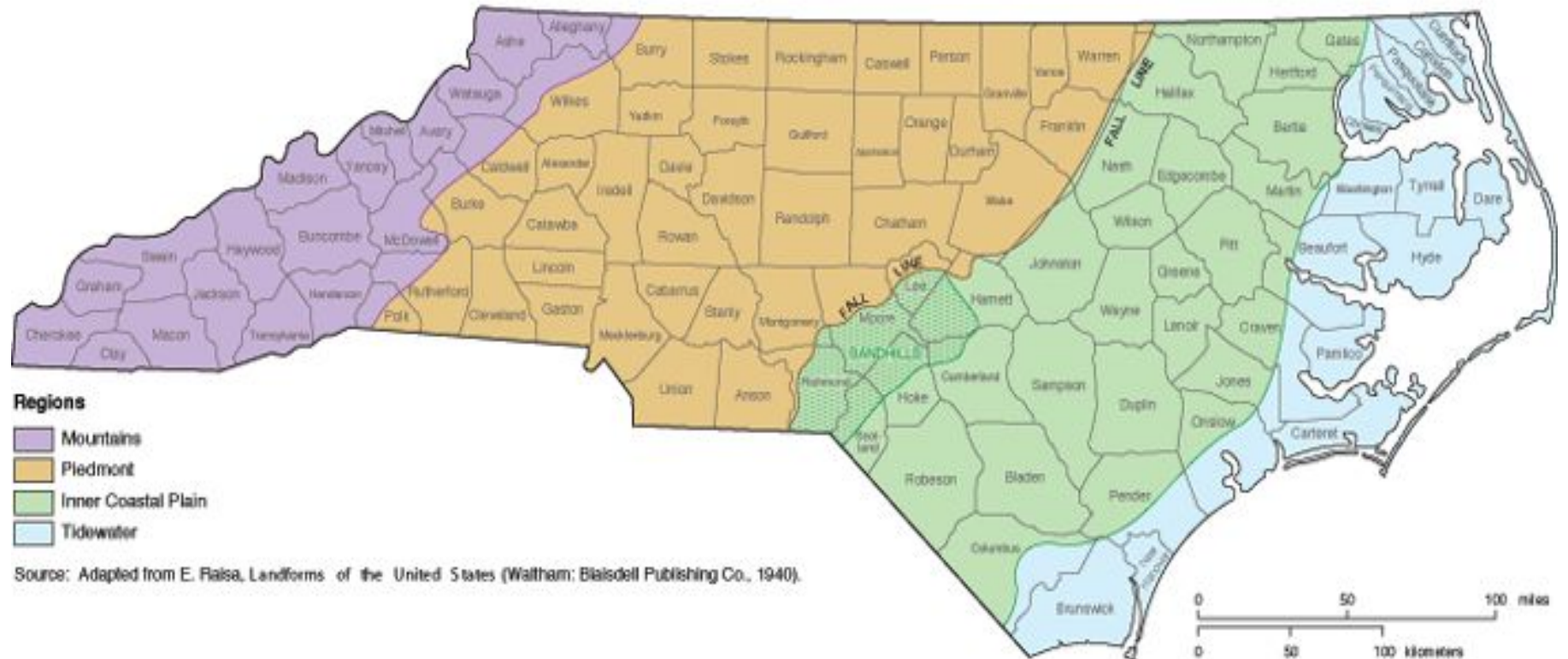
# James K Polk

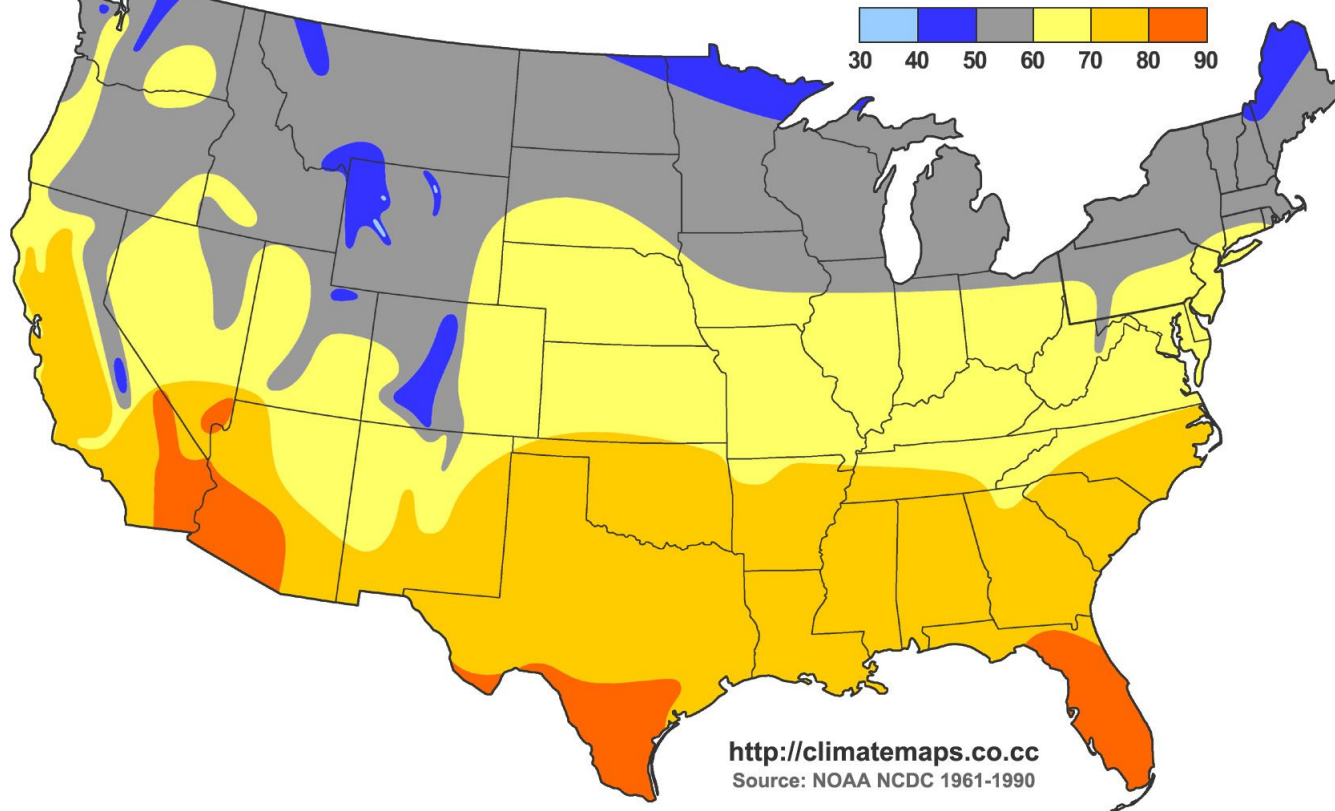

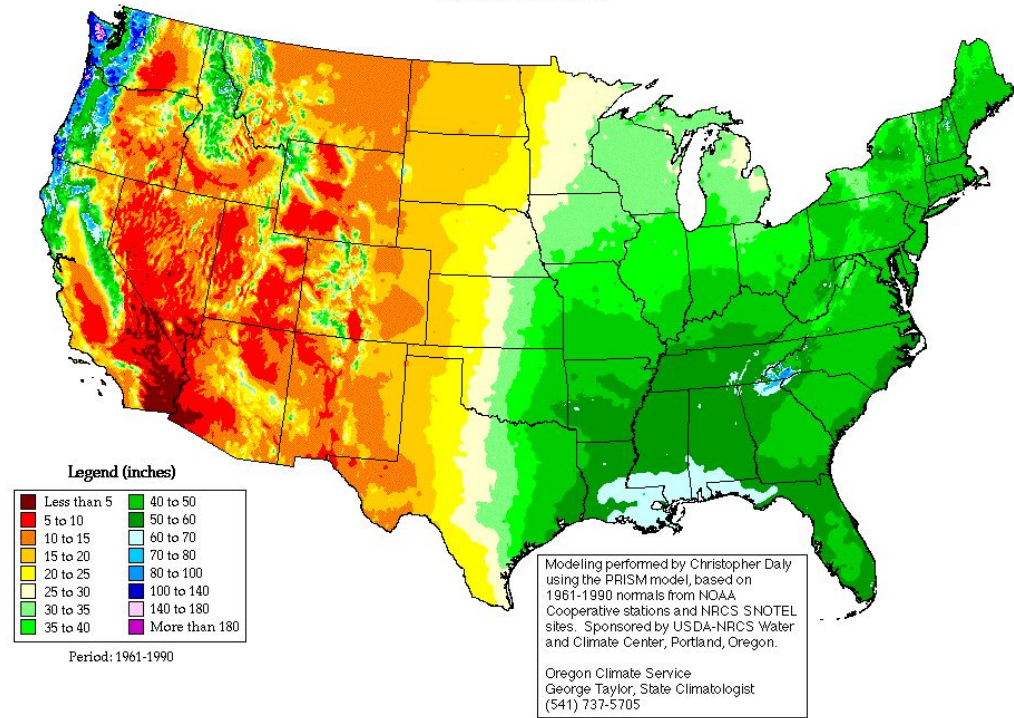
# US Weather

## Annual Average Max Temperature (°F)



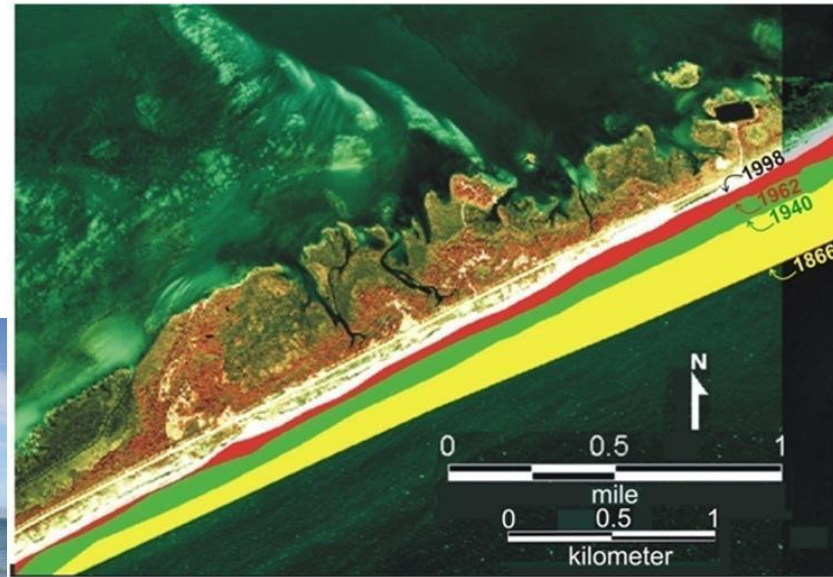
## Annual Average Precipitation

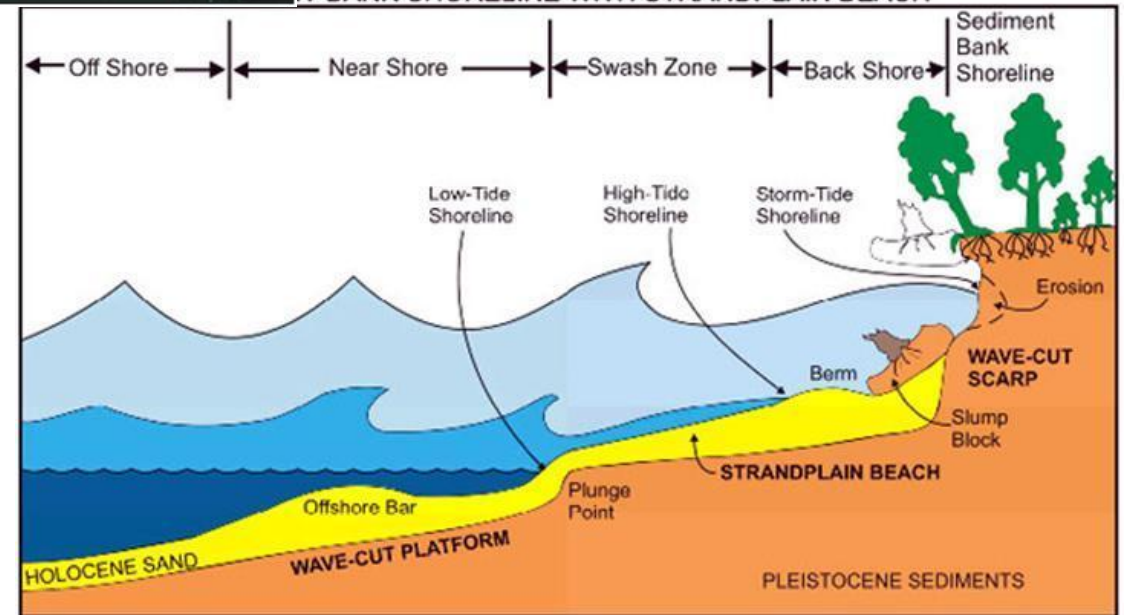
