- War of 1812 - American Revolution #2 - No winner, but the US doesn't lose
 - England and US will never fight again
- Expansion
 - Northwest Ordinance
 - Louisiana Purchase
 - Lewis and Clark
 - Manifest Destiny
 - Oregon Trail
 - California Gold Rush
 - New State - Slave or Free
 - Indian Removal Act
- Infrastructure and Industrialization
 - Roads, canals, railroads
 - Inventions
 - Factory Design
 - Eli Whitney - interchangeable parts & cotton gin
- Compromise
 - Great Compromises – Big States vs. Little States (constitution 1787)
 - 3/5th Compromise – Free States vs. Slave States (constitution 1787)
 - Missouri Compromise – No slavery north of Missouri
 - Compromise of 1850 – Popular Sovereignty to decide “slave or free state”
- Abolitionists
 - Dred Scott, Frederick Douglass, Harriet Tubman, William Lloyd Garrison
 - Harriet Beecher Stowe - Uncle Tom's Cabin
- Civil War (1861-1865)
 - South winning at first - more to fight for
 - North takes control
 - Gettysburg
 - Vicksburg
 - Too Many advantages
 - more people, industry, supplies, railroads
- Reconstruction (1865-1877)
 - Rebuild the south - Physically and Psychologically
 - constitutional amendments
 - 13 - ends slavery
 - 14 – African Americans are citizens
 - 15 – African American men can vote
 - Freedmen's Bureau - Government agency to designed to help African Americans
 - Southern Democrats lose power and right to vote
 - Compromise of 1877
 - Presidential election is a tie
 - Republicans (north) get the Presidents
 - Democrats (South) get the ending of Reconstruction
 - Jim Crow Laws are started (legal discrimination)
- Manifest Destiny 2
 - Technology, Railroads & Indian Removal from the West
 - Move West
 - Great Migration - African Americans move to Northern Cities
 - Immigration - Southern and Eastern Europe, Asia
 - Ellis Island & Angel Island ...America = Melting Pot
