

CENTRAL UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT APPLICATION FOR CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Governing Board of the Central Union High School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the implementation of the Measure K School Facilities Bond program.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On June 7, 2016, voters residing within the Central Union High School District passed Measure K. Measure K is a \$30 million bond measure that was approved on the June 7, 2016 ballot which authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the schools within the Central Union High School District. Proposition 39 requires a 55% majority for approval; this bond was passed by 70%.

Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Central Union High School District's Governing Board appoint a Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure K bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure K bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure K;
- Present to the Governing Board, in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure K bond proceeds.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Governing Board from applications submitted to the District.

Time Commitment and Term

Initial appointments will be staggered, such that some of the initial appointees will be appointed to serve one full two-year term. The other initial appointments will serve a one-year term but will be eligible for reappointment by the Governing Board for a second two-year term. Please see Bylaws for terms.
