



Central Union Adult High School School Bus Driver Training Course

To transport students safely in the state of California, the law requires that you have:

- * **A driver's license of the appropriate class**
- * **A Special School Bus Driver's Certificate**

You can obtain the appropriate license after you have a medical certificate from a doctor and by going to DMV to apply for a:

- **Class "B" Driver's license or (Class "A" license is acceptable)**
- **Passenger endorsement (P)**
- **School Bus endorsement (S)**

You can have a Special Drivers' Certificate after completing a minimum of 20 classroom hours from the Instructor's Manual for California's Bus Driver's Training Course and a minimum of 20 hours of Behind-the-wheel training. (Behind the wheel training will be provided by the company who hires you once you have passed all written examinations at DMV and CHP)

You can apply for a Special Driver's Certificate at the local CHP office after you have completed the following:

- **A class "B" driver's license with "P" and "S" endorsements (a permit from DMV is also ACCEPTABLE)**
- **Has completed a minimum of 20 classroom hours of instruction for school bus drivers.**
- **A clean driver's record for the last 3 years.**

***Has knowingly made a false statement or

***Suspension of driving privilege within
the last 3 years including back
pay on child support**

***Involved in 3 accidents within the last 12
months**

***Does not meet the minimum medical
standards**
