

CUHSD BEHAVIORAL GUIDELINES

STUDENT ACTION

MISCHIEVOUS BEHAVIOR

- Attendance (absences / tardies / etc.
- Class Disruptions
- Dress Code Violation
- Gambling / Gambling Devices
- Graffiti (personal belongings / first offense)
- No Show Detention / Saturday School
- Possession of Unauthorized Items (I-pods / Discmans /etc.)
- Trespassing: Unauthorized student in your class.
- Violation of School Rules
- Loitering / unsafe acts / not prepared for class/ use of cell phones
- Defiance-Minor

SEVERE BEHAVIOR

PERMISSIBLE / MANDATORY RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION

- Academic Expectations
- Cheating / forgery / plagiarism / etc.
- Profanity / Obscenity to students
- Profanity / Obscenity to staff
- Tobacco: Possession / use of Paraphernalia.
- Arson
- Campus Violence (mutual combat/battery)
- Drug Paraphernalia
- Firecrackers
- Harassment
- Stealing
- Received Stolen Property
- Drugs / Controlled Substances
 Marijuana / Narcotics / Alcohol
- Gang Related Fights
- Explosive Devices
- Thefts (Extortion / Robbery)
- Vandalism / Graffiti (major / second offense)
- Weapons / Dangerous Objects
- Overt Defiance

MISCHIEVOUS BEHAVIOR

- 1st Referral 1 hour immediate In-House suspension
- 2nd Referral 2 hours immediate In-House suspension
- 3rd Referral 4 hours immediate In-House suspension
- 4th Referral 1 day immediate In-House suspension or
Home Suspension
- 5th Referral Refer to Level 1 Severe Category

SEVERE BEHAVIOR

- 1st Severe 2 days In-House or Home suspension
- 2nd Severe 3 days Home suspension (Possible DAHP/SARB)
- 3rd Severe 5 days Home suspension (Possible DAHP/SARB)
- 4th Severe Refer to District Administrative Hearing Panel
(DAHP)/ or Expulsion
- 5th Severe Refer to School Attendance Review Board (SARB)
or Expulsion

The above consequences for Mischievous and Severe Behavior is assigned to each student depending on the seriousness of the behavior and is not limited to following the above order.
