Featured Grade Levels



The littles are emphasizing letters and sounds, introducing beginning sight words, learning about characters, setting and major events in a story. They are learning numbers 0-10 with counting, comparing numbers, ordinal numbers and sorting objects.



1st Grade- First graders are working on fluency and comprehension, while adding new sight words. They are learning about the main elements, the moral of a story and reading with expression. They are also learning to number patterns, place value and continue to practice counting to 120.

Fun Activities for Home:

Kinder Reading- Make an ABC book and/or a book of environmental print (ex. Walmart sign, McDonald's, cereal box labels) and practice reading it together.

Kinder Math- Roll and Write- get some dice- roll, count and practice writing the number(s)

1st Grade Reading- Practice the 5 finger retell after reading a story.



1st Grade Math- Take a walk and count your steps with your child- Count by 1's, 2's, 5' and 10's

At Home Activities for our Vineland Families

2nd Grade- Reading-Create a comfy reading space in your home and practice using expression while reading.

2nd Grade Math-sort dominoes or number cards into even and odd numbers and/or turn Yahtzee into a place value game.

3rd Grade- Reading- Give/Discuss background knowledge on books the books they are about to read -this knowledge increases comprehension

3rd Grade Math-practice addition or multiplication facts with a deck of cards.

4th and 5th Grade- Reading- They are now reading to learn-try the read and think method- have the child read and then ask him/her- Do you understand what you read? Have the child summarize what he/she learned/read.

4/5 Math- Play Scrabble and have the child keep score and/or play multiplication war with a deck of cards.
