We hope all of you are doing well. We understand that everyone is piloting through new territory when it comes to student learning. However, it will not be an impossible task. We will do our best to guide you and our students through this process. Thank you for taking the time to speak with your child's teacher this week - it will be important that we stay in communication to make sure that you have what you need to be successful.

Students are comfortable using these programs in ClassLink. Each week you student will need to complete the following:

- 180 minutes of i-Ready reading weekly
- 180 minutes of i-Ready math weekly
- Read 100 minutes weekly using the large assortment of books on myON, Epic, or TumbleBooks and take an AR test on Renaissance for the books they complete.
- Grades 3-5 students also need to go on USATest Prep to complete 10 videos and comprehension checks weekly

Be on the lookout for additional information from your teacher for optional learning opportunities. Specials teachers will also post weekly activities on the SJE website under the E-Learning tab.

Also, on Monday, March 30th, students will complete an i-Ready math and i-Ready diagnostic. These tests will set the students' instructional path on i-Ready. Please allow ample time for this test and give breaks as needed. It is important that students complete this diagnostic independently as this is how their learning path is set. Assistance will result in students getting a learning path that is too difficult. Also make sure students have paper and pencil for the math portion of the assessment.
