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## **Recertification Requirements FAQs**

**Do I need 20 in-service points to recertify even if I am not certified in Exceptional Student Education (ESE)?** FLDOE requires 120 total in-service hours or points earned during your certification window. This includes 100 hours of generic in-service and 20 hours in teaching students with disabilities (SWD). This applies to all teacher certificate renewal regardless of area(s) of certification.

What if I earn more than 20 hours during my recertification window? Extra unused SWD/ESE points can be banked for future use as can Reading and ESOL endorsement points.
