I am incredibly honored and excited to be teaching the *new* Creative Writing elective that is being offered at L.A. Ainger this year. Over the course of the semester, students will develop and use writing and language skills for creative expression in a variety of literary forms. Students will be exposed to and will be tasked to model from a variety of short literary collections, including poetry, one-act plays, short stories, and memoirs

With the reintroduction of state-administered written tests this year, my goal for this course is to inspire students to find value and enjoyment in producing their own writing, as well as improving their grammar, organization, and collaboration skills to meet state standards. In this class, students will...

- **study** of a variety of short literary collections, including poetry, one-act plays, short stories, and memoirs to practice or identify:
 - the use of figurative, denotative, and connotative language
 - identifying and applying story structure, poetic forms, and creative pacing techniques
 - the reciprocal nature of content and form
- write for varied purposes and in varied genres, including:
 - personal and dramatic narratives
 - various poetic forms
 - plays and multimedia productions
 - multi-genre and creative nonfiction selections
 - digital writing platforms
 - collaboration amongst peers, especially regarding peer reviews of multiple drafts

Academic Assessment: Grading will be based on a combination of the following:

- Projects
- Writing
- Notebook checks
- Class participation and collaboration
