## Washington State Seal of Biliteracy Test - November 6th

The Washington State Seal of Biliteracy was established to recognize public high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing in one or more world languages in addition to English. "Participating school districts with students eligible to receive the Seal, shall place a notation on a student's high school diploma and high school transcript indicating that the student has earned the seal." (RCW 28A.300.575 / RCW 28A.230.125)

Graduating high school students must meet the following criteria to be awarded the Seal:

- Demonstrate proficiency in English by meeting the graduation requirements in English and meeting standard on reading and writing or English language arts assessments; and
- Demonstrate proficiency in one or more world languages.

The College and Career fair is an opportunity for students to gather information about some of the options available to them after graduation, and to make connections with a wide variety of colleges and vocations. Be sure to ask your student about this event!

Great news! Our school has partnered with Smile Programs, the mobile dentists, to offer in-school dental care on **December 1st**. Sign up your child today at [www.myschooldentist.com](http://www.myschooldentist.com) or request permission slips from the office. Paper permission slips are due back **November 3<sup>rd</sup>**.

Dental care provided through this program is usually at no cost to you. All insurance is accepted including Medicaid and CHIP. For those without insurance, a low cost self-pay option is available. The in-school dental program saves you time and provides a safe and comfortable place for your child to receive gentle dental care from licensed local professionals.

Dental care includes a complete dental exam, x-rays, cleaning, fluoride and sealants when necessary, and in some cases, restorative care such as fillings.



**Children who see a dentist regularly may have fewer health issues like:**

Early tooth loss due to dental decay  
Gum disease  
Heart disease  
Impaired speech development

#### Title I Notification

Parents can request the following information regarding instructional staff who work with their children:

- Whether or not the child's teacher has met state certification for the grades and subjects she/he is teaching.
- Whether or not the teacher is working with an emergency or conditional certificate where state certification criteria has been waived.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held, including field of discipline of the certificate or degree.
- If the child receives instructional services from a paraeducator, the paraeducator's qualifications.

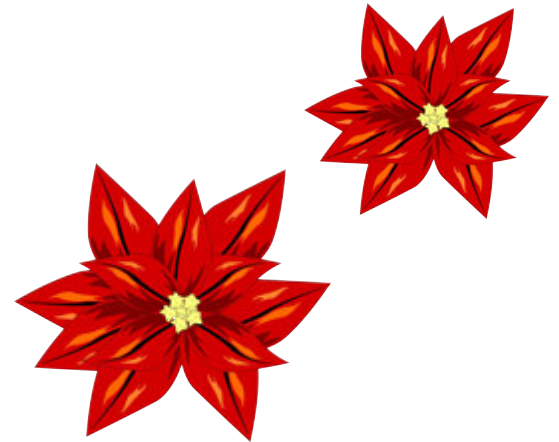

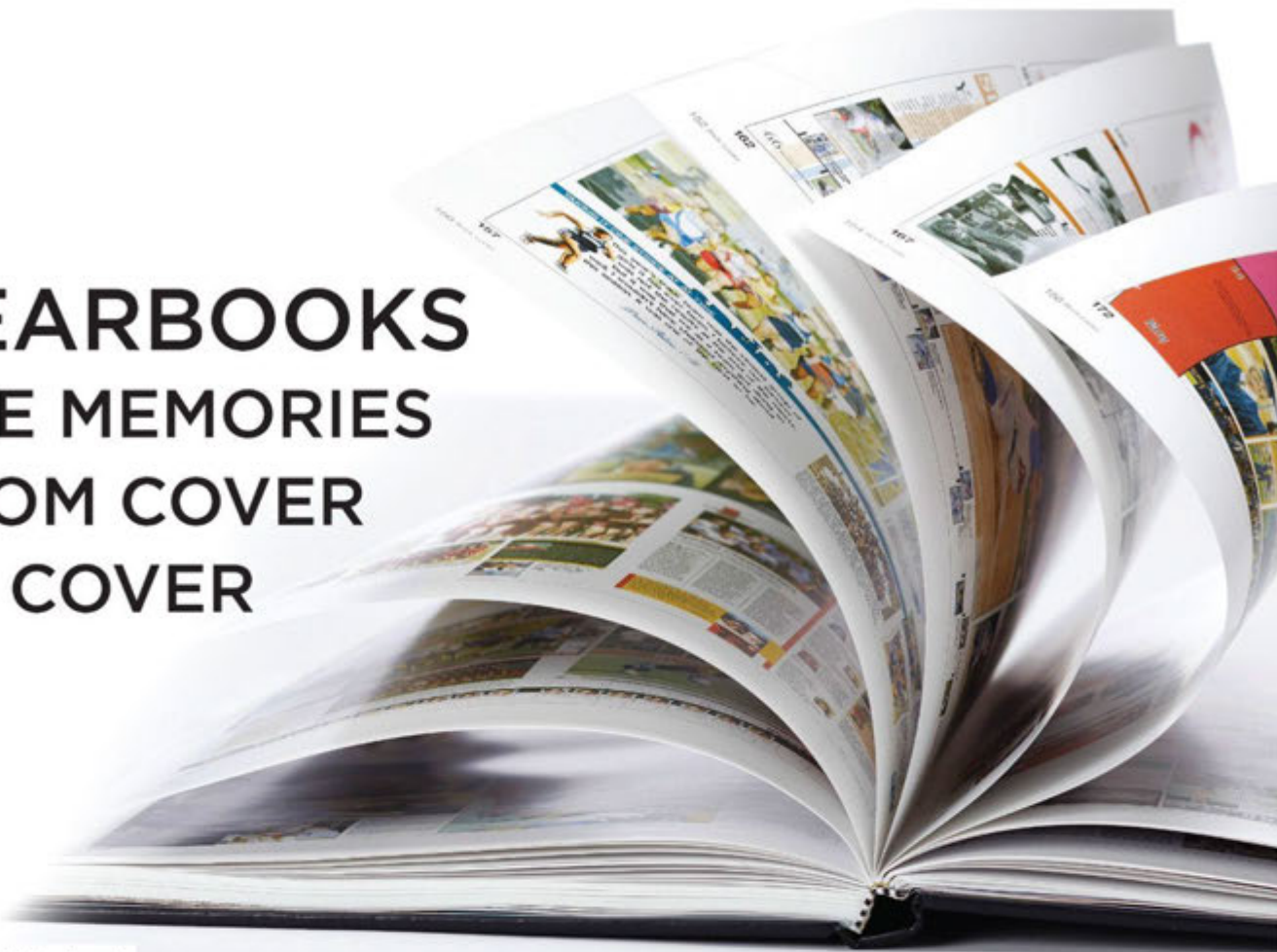

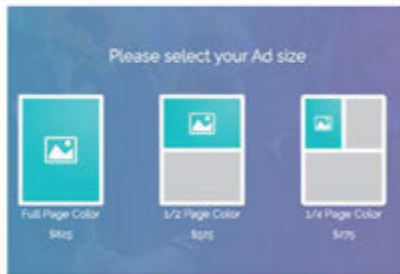
