

2023-24 Proposition 28 – Arts and Music in Schools Funding Annual Report

Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.

In the 2023-24 school year, Clovis Online Charter School did not spend their apportionment from Prop 28. Instead, they focused on planning the most effective way to develop an arts education program for their diverse student population that would provide a quality art program led by a certificated art teacher. Clovis Online Charter lacked an arts program from a certificated art teacher that provided instructional, hands on, in person and virtual lab component to further engage students in the arts. This need prompted efforts to create a relevant program in the 2024-25 fiscal year starting with the recruitment of a certificated art teacher.

Clovis Online Charter's dedication to fostering creativity, talent, and a love for the arts among its students is evident through its commitment to improving arts education via the Prop 28 programs.
