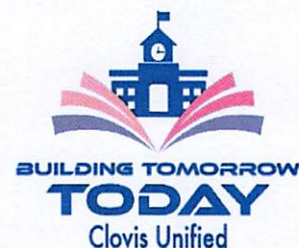



<p>Welcome-Robyn Snyder Call to Order & Approval of Minutes –Ada Martinez / Maria Miguel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Welcome to All• Public Comments• Approval of January 17, 2023, minutes	<p>*Robyn Snyder welcomed the committee to the meeting and called the meeting to order at 9:00am</p> <p>*Ada Martinez welcomed the committee for joining us this morning and introduced Maria Miguel.</p> <p>*Robyn Snyder asked for public comments, but none were brought forward.</p> <p>*Robyn Snyder then asked the committee to review the minutes from the last meeting. She asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Laura Ramirez made a motion. Ada Martinez seconded. All were in favor.</p>
<p>Presentation -Saul Salinas and Laura Reynolds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• IDAC History and Purpose• IDAC Samples	<p>*Robyn Snyder introduced Saul Salinas to present on IDAC.</p> <p>*Saul Salinas welcomed parents and showed a video about one of our student conferences and explained about the student conferences.</p> <p>*Saul Salinas then explained the purpose of IDAC and CLASSI III and how it aligns to the district’s strategic plan.</p> <p>*Saul Salinas then explained the 13 components of IDAC in-depth to the committee and explained how it is an accountability measure for our school sites.</p> <p>*Saul Salinas explained the importance of both students and parents and their roles in the DELAC, ELAC, and with involvement at the school sites. He also really stressed the importance of student voice on our campuses.</p> <p>*Saul also explained that this is an on-going process within our district.</p> <p>*Saul asked if there were any questions and Mrs. Martinez asked if there were certain times for kids to be involved in HRC. Mr. Salinas explained that it differs at every site and gave an example of lunch meetings.</p> <p>*Mr. Salinas then explained that every site has a parent IDAC and a student IDAC/HRC/PASA as a requirement of the district. He shared that these are both important pieces to making sure our kids and families feel like they belong.</p> <p>*He then showed the district IDAC website and explained that every school site has an IDAC website that you can look at any time.</p> <p>*Mr. Salinas then explained the IDAC site visits to the committee and explained how any parent can be a part of the visiting teams. He then showed a video that illustrated this year’s IDAC site visits so the committee could see what they entail.</p> <p>*Mr. Salinas thanked the committee for being involved with their schools and the district and asked if there were any questions.</p> <p>**Sabina Hernandez thanked Mr. Salinas for presenting on the topic.</p>

	<p>**Maria Miguel asked if IDAC is at all of the schools and Mr. Salinas explained that they are at all schools except Gateway and Community Day.</p> <p>**Ada Martinez shared that she didn't know IDAC existed at her school, and she thanked Mr. Salinas for presenting. He explained that he is happy to bring the presentation to the ELAC or IDAC at their school site.</p> <p>**Sabina Hernandez explained her experience at her school with her student. Saul explained how important it is for the parents to talk to the school, so they know what is happening and can help. She also expressed that there is not always translation available at her school.</p> <p>**Maria Valencia shared that she has seen a huge improvement in her students since they started CUSD vs FUSD and that she is very happy here.</p> <p>*Mrs. Snyder thanked Mr. Salinas for presenting.</p>
<p>Program Business:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CUSD LCAP Update- Dr. Pa Vue • ASES (After School Education and Safety) • CUSD Categorical Program Funding • Consolidated Application • EL Masterplan 	<p>*Robyn Snyder explained that Dr. Vue couldn't make it today. She then presented on the LCAP process and let the committee know that at the May meeting we will be reviewing the full LCAP plan and that parents will get the link to the plan prior to the meeting so they can review ahead of time.</p> <p>*Robyn Snyder then shared with the committee that ASES is changing to ELOP for next year.</p> <p>*Robyn Snyder then discussed the categorical funding that is available to our district and explained the consolidated application for federal funds. Mrs. Snyder asked for a motion to approve the application for the Con App. Laura Ramirez made a motion. Ada Martinez seconded, and all were in favor.</p> <p>*Robyn Snyder and Lisa Vuola presented on the master plan revisions and asked if there were any questions.</p> <p>**Cindy Alcaraz shared her concerns about the lack of electives if her student is in ELD. Lisa Vuola shared that we are working to address that in the revised master plan.</p> <p>**Ada Martinez thanked the district for revising the master plan and considering the parents' feedback. She also expressed that she wants her students to get an elective.</p> <p>**Parents were thankful for the master plan revisions.</p>
