Passes Bring Increased Safety, Efficiency to Buses

Kicking off the new school year also means kicking off new safety improvements for students riding Clovis Unified's buses. A simple swipe of our new Tyler Drive bus pass brings parents and drivers peace of mind knowing when and where students are boarding and exiting the bus.

Students riding Clovis Unified school buses for home-to-school transportation will now use the Tyler Drive bus pass to record their entry and exit from the school bus. This allows drivers to confirm students are on the right bus, and use their correct stop.

If your student is eligible for transportation but has not received a pass by the second week of school, contact the Transportation Department at 559.327.9701. Tyler Drive bus passes allow Clovis Unified bus drivers to know that students are on the right bus and using the right bus stop.



When will my child get their bus pass?

Students in intermediate or high school should have received their passes during walk-through registration or when student ID cards were issued.

Elementary-aged students will receive their bus pass when using the school bus during the first week of school.

Passes will need to be used every time your child enters and exits the bus.

Passes won't be in use on:

- Special Education Routes
- Recreation Routes
- Field Trips
