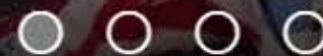

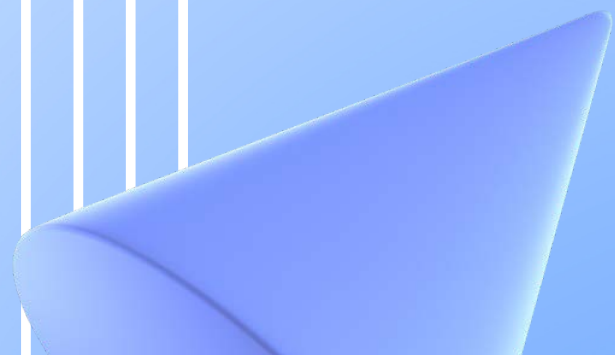

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

If you earn an F in a *required* academic class, you **MUST** repeat it during summer school.

If you earn an F, you're in jeopardy of not graduating and need to make a plan with your Counselor to get back on track.

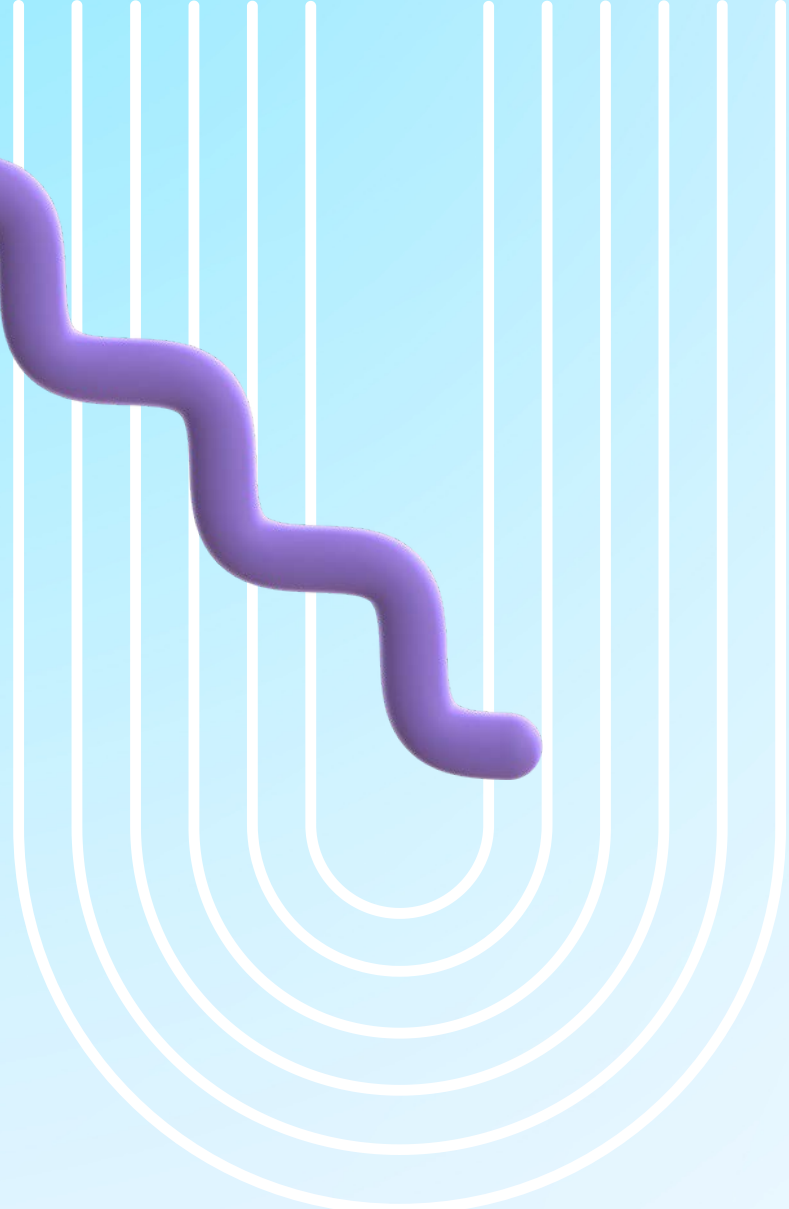
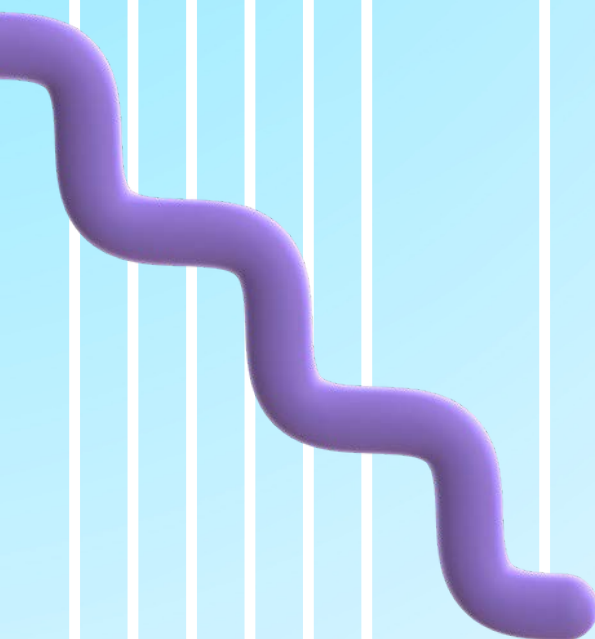
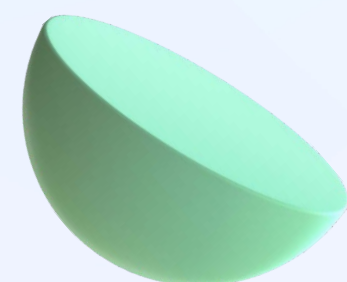
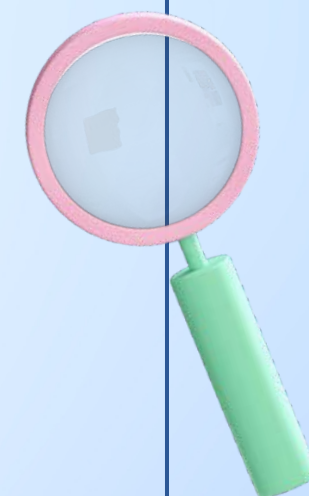


2-YEAR VS. 4-YEAR COLLEGE
