





Des Bishop is an Irish-American comedian. His comedy is based heavily on his observations of Irish society. He was born in the United States and resides in Ireland.









James Hoban was an Irish Catholic architect. He was best known for designing the White House in Washington, D.C. He emigrated to the United States after the American Revolutionary War.


James HOBAN

General, Statesman, and Former US President






Tom Monaghan is an Irish American entrepreneur who founded Domino's Pizza in 1960. He owned the Detroit Tigers from 1983 to 1992.





Born to an Irish American Catholic family, Molly Shannon is an actress who was a cast member on Saturday Night Live from 1995 to 2001.




Molly SHANNON


