Air & Space Force Reserve Officer Training Corps

- 4-year program designed to train/evaluate future officers in the United States Air Force and United States Space Force
- Cadets will take an Aerospace Studies course, a Leadership Lab, and will attend Physical Training (PT) two times per week (0545 Tu/Th)
- *Can be a 3-year program for high performing, motivated students only, by combining the freshman and sophomore year's curriculum. Approved by the Det/CC on a case by case basis. See *dual enrolled sophomores* note below for specific class registration requirements.

Admission Requirements

Academic

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more per term) at Fresno State or one of our crosstown schools (Fresno City, Clovis Community, Reedley College, Merced College, or College of the Sequoias)
- Must have at least 3 years remaining before graduating with your undergraduate degree
- If you have previously taken college-level courses, you must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0

Fitness

- Be in good physical condition and able to pass a Physical Fitness Assessment (consisting of a 1.5 mile run, pushups, sit-ups, and abdominal circumference) once per semester
- All cadets must conform to the maximum weight and body fat standards as established by the United States Air Force

Medical

All cadets must meet Department of Defense Medical Examination & Review Board (DODMERB) criteria

Age

- 14 years of age or older (17 years or older to receive a scholarship)
- Rated (Pilot, Combat Systems Officer, Air Battle Manager and Remotely Piloted Aircraft Pilot) must commission before reaching the age of 29
- Scholarship applicants must be younger than 31 years old as of December 31 of the year you will be commissioned
- Tech, nontech, and nonrated—commissioned by age 39 (waiverable up to age 42)

Citizenship

Must be able to obtain citizenship no later than the end of cadet's junior year

Scholarships

- In order for a cadet to be eligible for the in-college scholarship, he/she must:
 - Have at or above a 3.0 Cumulative / 2.5 Term GPA
 - Have passed the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT; similar to SAT/ACT)
 - o Be DODMERB (medically) qualified
 - o Be within Height/Weight and Body Fat Standards
 - o Pass the Air Force Fitness Assessment
- All scholarships pay:
 - o Full tuition/fees at Fresno State or any of our crosstown institutions
 - o \$900/year for books
 - o Monthly stipend (Freshman: \$300, Sophomore: \$350, Junior: \$450, Senior: \$500)

Classes (Each Semester)

A classes are offered--Fall semester, B classes are offered--Spring semester

Freshman

- ASP 1, Heritage & Values, 1 credit hour, 50 minutes
- ASP 3, Leadership Lab I (General Military Course), 1 credit hour, 120 minutes

Sophomore

- ASP 2, The Evolution of Aerospace Studies I, 1 credit hour, 75 minutes
- ASP 3, Leadership Lab I (General Military Course), 1 credit hour, 120 minutes
- Dual enrolled sophomores must take ASP 1A/1B AND ASP 2A/2B concurrently

Junior

- ASP 3, Air Force Leadership Studies, 3 credit hours
- ASP 113, Leadership Lab I (Professional Officer Course), 1 credit hour, 120 minutes

Senior

- ASP 4, National Security Affairs, 3 credit hours
- ASP 113, Leadership Lab (Professional Officer Course), 1 credit hour, 120 minutes
