

Is THIS in dress code?

The results of the 2021 Dress Code study are in, and Clovis Unified's Governing Board has updated the district's dress code found in Board Policy 5132. Updates focus on creating a code **more accessible to families, while continuing to promote a healthy and high quality learning environment**. The following guide helps answer questions about what is, and is not, in the updated dress code.

Frays and Holes

Garments are to be **stitched evenly around**, and if frayed, must be stitched to avoid further fraying. Distressing is allowable. **Holes in clothing must be patched from behind** so that no undergarments or bare skin is exposed.



Shorts

Shorts should be evenly hemmed and have an **inseam of at least five inches (5")**. Spandex or Lycra shorts are not permissible.



Leggings

Leggings and jeggings are permitted but **cannot be see through or have mesh or ruching above the knee**. Tops worn with leggings and jeggings **must not expose midriffs** at any time during school or school-sponsored activities or events.



Camouflage

Camouflage patterns will be allowed.



Hair

Hair, beard or mustache styles should be neatly groomed and **not create disruptions** to the learning environment.
