DATES	<p>Monday, June 17th through Thursday, July 25th 22 Instructional Days Session 1: June 17, 2024- July 3, 2024 Session 2: July 8, 2024- July 25, 2024 ** No school on Fridays **No school on Wednesday, June 19th and Thursday, July 4th</p>
CLASS TIMES	<p>Daily (Monday – Thursday) 8:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.</p>
PURPOSE	<p>To make up failing grade(s) for grade promotion or graduation requirements. NOTE: There will be in-class instruction for <u>selected courses only</u>. Please see your counselor.</p>
NOTIFICATION	<p>Registration occurs at the student’s regular high school site. HS Counselor will register students. Parent Connect may be accessed to view student’s summer school schedule in late May.</p>
CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY	<p>To be eligible to enroll in credit recovery, a student must be an enrolled CUSD student <i>and</i> meet one of the following two criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be an incoming student in grades 10 – 12 that <u>must repeat a course</u> due to D or F or ▪ Must be deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.
ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY	<p>For a student to take an Original Credit course in Summer School, the student must meet the following three criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Have an impacted schedule for the following school year <u>and</u> ▪ Possess a 3.0 or higher Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for exceptional circumstances) <u>and</u> ▪ Possess self-discipline, self-motivation, and be able to work independently
LUNCH	Lunch will be provided to all students through the Summer Seamless program.

TRANSPORTATION	Will be provided from pre-selected elementary sites. See CUSD Website for details.
ATTENDANCE	<p>Students are required to attend full class hours daily Monday – Thursday.</p> <p><i>ONLY 2 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION CAN BE MISSED. Work must be made up. Any student missing more than two absences will be dropped after the 2nd absence.</i></p> <p>Absence = Family vacation, court, illness, school sponsored function, being sent home for dress code or a conduct violation.</p>
STUDENT CONDUCT & DRESS CODE	<p>All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code:</p> <p>Conduct: Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct. Students who break the California Education Code are eligible for suspension. If a student is suspended, and the resulting effect is that they miss too many classes as defined by the summer school attendance policy, will be dropped after serving their suspension. <i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action.</i></p> <p>Dress Code: Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments. Students out of dress code will be sent home and marked absent.</p>
TRANSCRIPT	<p>Drop Procedures with no credits earned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Drop before end of 1st week – Not recorded on HS Transcript ● Drops after 1st week: Record Class with NG (No Grade) <p>Once a course is completed, grades and credits will be posted on the students' transcript. <u>Summer School grade postings are permanent and may not be deleted.</u> Summer School courses may be repeated at the school site ONLY if the grade earned was a D or F.</p>
