

Typical 7th Grade Schedule

- Academic Block (AB) Language & History
- General Science 7 or Advanced Science 7
- Math 7 or Advanced Math 7
- PE (Zero period or lunch period PE is possible for students wanting two electives: see requirements below)
- Elective Choice (please refer to the Info sheet w/ elective descriptions and potential prerequisites)

All 7th grade students will be placed in laptop academic block. Students have the option to purchase their own laptop or use one provided by the school.

All 7th grade students will need to pick a performing art elective.

Non-Application Electives

*Electives below **DO NOT** require a recommendation or application.*

These elective options are only offered based on student enrollment

- Forensics (Speech & Debate)
(8th grade given priority)
- Art/Teen Living
- Film Studies/ Exploring Technology
- Intervention courses (math strategies, academic seminar, study strategies, ELD, RSP Study Skills)

Performing Arts

*Electives below **DO NOT** require a recommendation or application.*

- Band
- Percussion
- Color Guard
- Orchestra
- Soprano Alto Choir (girls)
- Tenor Bass Choir (boys)
- Beginning Drama

Application Electives-

Electives below require an application: Due March 31st

- AVID
- Peer Counseling
- Leadership
- Yearbook

CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING:

- You will be enrolled in ONE of your four selected electives.
- At least ONE of your elective choices must be a non-application elective
- Students requiring **academic intervention** may be enrolled in Study Skills (RSP), ELD, Academic Seminar, Study Strategies, or Math Strategies as their elective.
- Please understand that all elective choices are subject to availability and are NOT guaranteed.
- **IMPORTANT: Class balancing takes place within the first two weeks of the school year. Class schedules may be subject to change.**
- **NO schedule changes will be made unless you are placed in the wrong class. We will not honor period change or teacher change requests.**

PE REQUEST:

All students will be enrolled in PE. If a student wants to take 2 electives, they may choose to take zero period or lunch period PE to accommodate 2 electives.

All combinations of electives apart from Teen Living/Art, Film Studies/Exploring Technology, and Weightlifting, will qualify a student for zero period or lunch PE.

Zero Period PE: PE held before school at 7:20 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday (not on Wednesdays)

Lunch PE: Students meet every day at lunch for PE. Students will have a short time to eat, and then report to PE.
