 - UC: should consider Honors Programs offered at Community College and discuss possible transfer agreements that may ensure admission (TAG Program)
 - CSU: meet with college transfer counselor and make sure they have completed prerequisites
 - Private: visit individual college website for transfer requirements and prerequisites

TESTING

- **Community College:**
 - English and math placement based on highest level of Math and English completed in high school in conjunction with student's GPA.
- **CSU/UC**
 - SAT and ACT not required by the CSU/UC system
 - SAT essay and subject tests eliminated indefinitely
- **Private/Out of State:**
 - Please visit college website for individual testing requirements

NCAA-

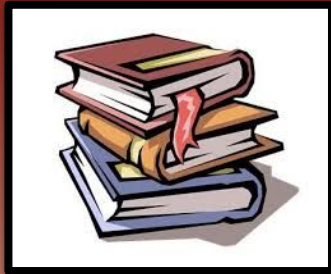
- Responsible for determining eligibility for student athletes for Div I and II
- Athletes need to register with the NCAA by end of their junior year at www.eligibilitycenter.org
- Requirements include 16 core courses for Div I and Div II
- Students must sign Transcript Release Form and submit to counselor.

NAIA-

- Any student interested in playing sports at NAIA colleges must have their eligibility determined by the NAIA eligibility center at www.playnaia.org

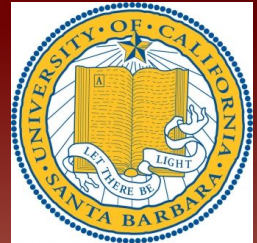

- Math Tutoring- Show up to the correct class for the subject needed.

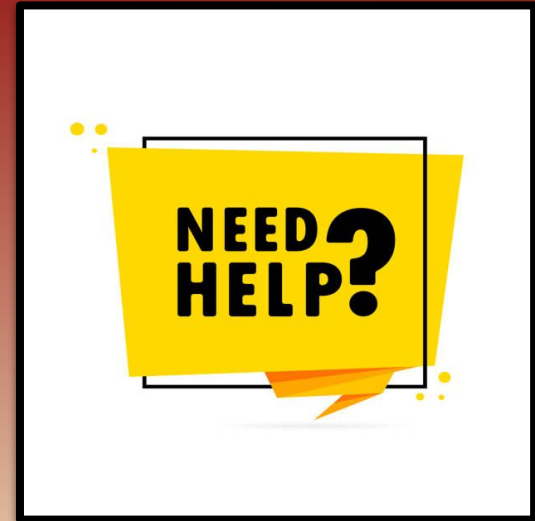
Additional Labs, Interventions, and Support Tools
