To be a Math Marlin, a student must:

- 1. Complete 3 math fact sheets for each of the grade level requirements.
- 2. Each math fact sheet must be completed with 100% accuracy.
- 3. Each math fact sheet should be completed in four minutes.
- 4. The deadline for being a Math Marlin is May 16th, 2025.
- 5. Teachers submit names of Math Marlins upon achievement for names to be read on announcements.
- 6. Principal's All-Stars to be submitted at the end of each quarter.
