### **Bell Schedule**



- We will return to our pre-COVID bell schedule with full day instruction for grades 1-6 and half day AM/PM instruction for TK/K.
- Grades 1-6 may arrive on campus at 8:05 for morning recess. The bell will ring at 8:25 for students to line up on the black top.
- Grades 1-6 will be released from class at 3:15 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. They will be released from class on Wednesday at 1:45.
- AM TK/K will be 8:10-11:40 (Wed. 8:10-10:55)
- PM TK/K will be 11:45-3:15 (Wed. 11:00-1:45)

## Physical Distancing, Masks, & hand sanitizing

- At this time, we are planning that adults will continue to socially distance 6-feet and students will socially distance 3-feet.
- Primary and TK/K class caps will be 27
- Upper grade class caps may reduce from 37 to 34 or 32. We may have to hire more staff to accomplish this.
- At this time, we believe that staff and students will likely wear masks unless eating, drinking, or at a mask break.
- Students will likely sanitize hands before eating and entering the classroom.



## Library



- We do not yet know if the library will be open for students. We hope that it will be.
- If not, we will continue to have library time with Mrs. Hedrick going directly to classrooms.
- We will continue to be creative in finding a way for Cubs to check out books and participate in AR.



- We anticipate purchasing more laptops and Chromebooks as funding allows. Our longterm goal is to have a laptop or Chromebook cart per classroom.
- We will not be asking students to bring devices from home.
- At this time, we are not anticipating checking out devices to students.



#### Recesses

- We will have recess next year but may have to adjust how many students are outside playing at a time.
- The kindergarten play structure should continue to be open.
- We do not yet know if the grades 1-6 play structure will open, but we hope it will.
- Currently students may remove their masks at mask breaks if socially distanced. That may continue.
- Currently kinder students must wear masks while on the play structure.
- All rules regarding mask wearing and social distance protocols are given to schools by the CDC and the Fresno County Department of Health and we, as a school site, are required to follow that guidance.

## Lunch



#### • We will be serving lunch on campus.

- We anticipate that this may be outside, as much as possible, or with safety precautions in place inside the Cub Café.
- We many need to adjust how many classes eat lunch at the same time for social distancing.

# Drop Off & Pick Up

- May not be as structured as this year.
- May look more like a traditional drop off and pick up process.



## **Field Trips**

- We are planning on 6<sup>th</sup> grade going to Sonora with safety measures and social distancing in place.
- We are planning on field trips in our other grade levels with safety measures and social distancing in place if the venues are open for field trips.

## **Campus Club**

- Campus Club is looking at re-opening feebased Campus Club next year.
- We are still waiting for details.

### **Student Vaccines**

- We have not yet heard if vaccines will be available to elementary school students.
- At this time there is no indication that vaccines will be required for students or staff.

## **Co-Curricular Activities**

- We anticipate that we will be able to bring back all elementary sports during their pre-COVID seasons.
- Sports practice will return to Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 3:20-4:20 with games on Fridays.
- We anticipate that we will be able to bring back choir, band, orchestra, academic clubs, and performance clubs.



# **Online Options**

- We are exploring online options for families wishing to remain online.
- This may include the Clovis Online School and/or some form of Clovis Connect. We believe that parents will be surveyed for their input.
- Teachers will not simultaneously teach both in person and online as was done by many teachers this year.
