# Welcome to Orchestra (Strings) at Maple Creek

Dear Parents,

I am Ms. Olson, strings director at Maple Creek. Your child has chosen to participate or continue to participate in the Maple Creek Strings Program and that comes with extra responsibility. Please read this letter carefully so that you and your child understand their responsibilities.

Please see the attached calendar for rehearsal and performance schedules.

\*ALL PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY UNLESS EMERGENCY OR PRIOR NOTICE\*

Students who participate in strings will receive an effort grade of an **O for outstanding**, **S for satisfactory or N for needs improvement**.

- To receive an O, your child must attend all performances (attendance will be taken), participate in class and have good classroom behavior.
- To receive an S, your child may have missed one performance, have some classroom participation and have minimal classroom behavioral problems.
- To receive an N, your child will have missed one or more performances, not participated in class and have had several classroom behavioral problems.

Please note that strings is a **2-year** commitment and a student **will not be allowed to quit** strings or switch into choir or band without completing the written application form and a parent-teacher conference. Strings students should practice at home to be successful. Periodic playing tests will be given in class to assess the students' progress on the instrument. Students are expected to bring instruments and supplies (music folders, shoulder rests, etc...) to school on days when music classes are scheduled.

**Block H**: Students can earn Block H points by participating in strings. Block H is the highest achievement a  $5^{th}$  or  $6^{th}$  grader can achieve. By being in a co-curricular activity such as strings your child can earn Block H points by attending performances and earning an "O" or "S" in strings. (**O**utstanding or **S**atisfactory)

**Strings Uniform**: Strings students are expected to 'dress up' in nice clothes for our performances.

**Behavior in Class:** Due to the large numbers of students in strings, it is necessary to be on our best behavior at all times. My expectations are high but achievable, so I expect each student to be on task and use good judgment when making decisions.

First Offense: Verbal warning and mark in book if they forgot instrument/music.

Second Offense: Minor referral and mark in book for nature of offense.

**Third Offense**: Minor referral #2, and mark in book, and after school detention with a phone call home.

Parent Participation: Parent help is always welcome! If you would like to help the strings by being a chaperone when we travel, please feel free to email me.
