





#### **Overall Placement**


Students Assessed/Total: 477/554





Students Assessed/Total: 541/554




# Safety- Catapult EMS



## Safety- around campus

- Doors to classrooms are locked all day
- Routine sweeps of campus to look for suspicious activity/items
- Staff attended Active Shooter Training
- Monthly drills to practice evacuation, shelter-in-place, and lockdown

# Student behavior- rude v. mean v. bullying



### Student behavior- "self-defense"

- Any student involved in a physical behavior will receive appropriate consequences.
- Self-defense is defined as an inability to get away and there is no adult present.
  - At Miramonte there is ALWAYS and adult nearby.
- Example: in the bathroom, student is followed into a stall and pushed into the corner. They only way to get out is to shove the aggressor away
- Non-example: Playing on the grass at recess, and student gets hit.
  Student hits back
