 Closed daily from 11:30- 12:00 for Lunch



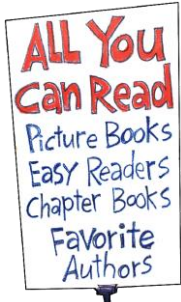
Scholastic will bring us a large selection of books, art & activity kits, and posters. We will have something for all ages. Parents do some early Christmas shopping!
